At a Court of General Sessions of the
Peace held at Elton by for said County on
the third day of April A.D. 1846 before
the Honorable the Judge of the said Court.
The Petition of Samuel Pleasant was presented. Representing that
he labors under inconvenience for want of a road from his
dwelling in Adams Township, through the land of George Lamb
to division line between George Lamb and Jacob Riefers, thence
along said division line to the Gratiot turn road in said
township near the new house of George Lamb, and thence
praying the Court to appoint three persons qualified according to
law, to view the place where said road is requested, &c.
Whereupon the Court upon due consideration, do order and
appoint Thomas McCampbell, George Richard Langh, and Joseph Conley
to view the ground proposed for said road, who after first being
duly sworn or affirmed according to law to discharge the duties
of the appointment with fidelity shall proceed to view the
same; and if all the said Viewers appointed view at same
and a majority of them agree there is occasion for such
road, they shall proceed to lay out the same as
agreedly to the wishes of the Petitioner as may be, having
respect to the best ground for a road and the shortest distance,
and in such manner as to do the least injury to
private property. The persons interested in the said road
having previously given public notice by letters or printed
advertisements of the time and place of meeting of said
Viewers for the purpose of laying said road at least ten days
before such meeting. If the Viewers aforesaid

Shall decide in favor of locating said road
it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the
persons through whose lands the road may pass
Release from any damages that may arise to them
in opening the same; and in every case when the
owners of such land refuse releasing their claim to
damages, the said Viewers shall assess the damages
and make report thereof before the majority of the Viewers
present, and transmit the same together with all
Releasees to the next Court of Quarter Session who filed
in said office with the papers relating to said road.

And the said Viewers shall make reports of
their proceedings hereon to the next Court of Quarter Session
to be held for said County, Accompanying the same
with a plan or Draft of said road with reference
to the improvements through which it passes, in which
Reports they shall state that they have been sworn or offered
oath, whether they judge the said road proper for a
Public or Private Road.

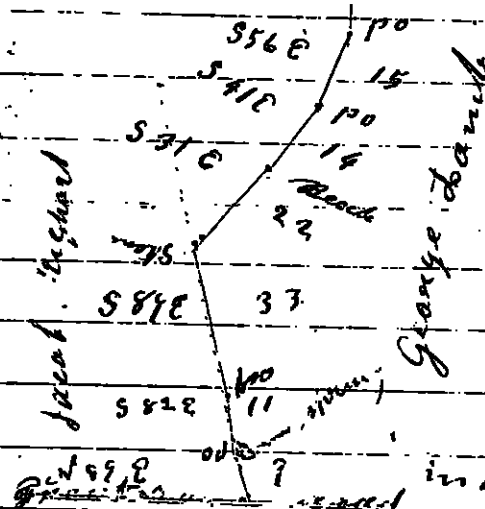
