At a Court of General Quarter Sessions
of the peace held at Eden by the
Cambria County on the twenty first
day of July in the Year of Our Lord
One thousand Eight hundred and
Seventy Six before the Honorable the Judge of the same
Court.

The petition of divers inhabitants of Gallitzin
township in said County was presented. Representing
that part of a public road in said township
leading from a point on the road running from
Dawson Mill to Gallitzin, to the Ashland Turnpike
road at or near Henry Baker's house, commencing near
the barn of John E. Palmer and ending near the house
of said Henry Baker, at the Ashland Turnpike Road
has become useless in consequence and burden to the
inhabitants of said township; said road having been laid
out many years but never fully opened for public use
and therefore praying the Court to appoint persons to locate
and supply the part of said road from Palmer's Barn to
the Ashland road by a road to commence at said
Barn and end at the point on the Ashland Turnpike
road where it is intersected by the Chest Ship road.

The Court upon due consideration of the premises
do order and appoint Arthur Elgin, David Paul E.
and William Charty to view the road proposed to be located
and supplied, who after having first been sworn on

affirmed to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, shall proceed to view Vacate and Supply the same, and if all the said Viewers appointed View the same, and a majority of them agree that there is occasion to Vacate and Supply said road, they shall proceed to do so as agreeably to the wishes of the Petitioners as may be, having respect to the best good for a Road and the Shortest distance, and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property.

The persons interested in said Road being fully given public notice by printed or written advertisements of the time and place when said View shall meet for the purpose of Vacating and Supplying said road, at least ten days before such meeting.

If the Viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of Vacating and Supplying said road, then it shall be the duty to obtain from the persons to whom lands the road may pass, releases from any damages that may arise to them in opening the same. And in every case when the owners of such lands refuse releasing their claim to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the damages, and make reports thereof signed by a majority of the said Viewers present and lay out the same together with all releases to the Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in said County together with the papers relating to said road.

And the said Viewers shall make reports of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in said County, accompanying the same

with a Pet or Draft of said Road, with reference
to the improvements through which it passes. in which
Reports they shall state that they have been sworn or
affirmed: and also, whether they judge the same
necessary for a Public or Private Road.
