Amherst County Ad.

At the Court of General Sessions
of the Peace held at Elizabethtown and
for Said Co. of Amherst on the 29th
day of October A.D. 1846. Before the Honorable the Judges of
the same just.

The Pleader, Citizen of White Township in said
County was present. Representing that they labored under great
inconvenience. The West of the Bridge across Clempfield Creek at
a place called Ingall's on the road leading from Elizabethtown
to Chilhowie, the former Bridge having been swept away; and
that the expense of Erecting Said Bridge would be laid
burdenous upon the inhabitants of Said Township; and praying
the Court to appoint proper persons to view the premises and to issue
such order as the subjects as is required and directed by the Act
of the General Assembly in such cases made and provided.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do
order and appoint John St. Langhans, Surveyor of Danville and
John Wagner to view the place proposed for Said Bridge, who having
first been duly sworn or affirmed to discharge the duties of their
Appointments faithfully, are to view the same: And if all the
Premises appointed bear the same, and a majority of the men
Agree that there is occasion for such a bridge, and that the
expense of Erecting the same would be no burden on said
Parish to bear, they shall make report accordingly. And the
Vicars are further authorized to examine the state of the road
crossing the Creek over which Said Bridge is proposed for,
and if in their opinion a change or variation in the location
of Said Bridge, or in the bed of the road can be an-

improvement or saving of expense in the erection of said bridge, they are to make report thereof and cause such variation as aforesaid to be accurately surveyed, and a map or Plot thereof to be made which shall accompany said report.

The Report aforesaid to be made to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County. In which Report they shall state that they have been sum or offend.
