

Camden County ss.

at a Court of General Sessions
of the Peace held at Eden by in and
for Said County of Carolina on the 29th
day of March A.D. 1876. Before the Honorable the Judges of
the said Court.

Five Petitioners being citizens of White Township in said
County was presented. Representing that they labored under great
inconvenience from want of a Bridge across Clematis Creek at
a place called Ingalls on the road leading from Salem Center
to Edenton, the former Bridge having been swept away; and
that the expense of erecting said Bridge would be too heavy and
burdensome upon the inhabitants of said Township; and praying
the Court to appoint proper persons to view the premises and to take
such order on the subject as is requisite and directed by the Act
of the General Assembly in such case made and provided.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do
Order and appoint John H. Senghaus, Mayor of Durham and
John Wagner to view the place proposed for said Bridge, who have
just been duly sworn or affirmed to discharge the duties of their
appointments with fidelity, and to view the same: And if all the
Petitioners appointed view the same, and a majority of the viewers
agree that there is occasion for such a bridge, and that the
expense of erecting the same would be too burdensome for said
Township to bear they shall make report accordingly. And the
viewers are further authorized to examine the route of the road
crossing the Creek over which said Bridge is proposed for,
and if in their opinion a change or variation in the location
of said Bridge, or in the bed of the road used to cross

improvement or saving of Expense in the erection of said
bridges, they are to make report thereof and cause such variations
as aforesaid to be accurately surveyed, and a map or Plot thereof
to be made which shall accompany said Report.

The Reports aforesaid to be made to the next Court of
Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County. In which
Report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed.
