At a Court of General Quarter Sessions
held at Elmsbury for said County on
the 9th day of November 1874, before the
Honble Judge of the same County.

The Petition of divers inhabitants of Washington Township and
parts adjacent in said County was presented setting forth
that they have under great incumbrance for want of a road
requiring at a public road leading from Main township
road on the lands of Warner Bender thence by the meadows
and best route until it intersects a Public Road leading
from Elmsbury to Putney on the land of Mr. Bromley in said
township. And praying the Court to appoint commissioners to
view and lay out the same accordingly to law.

The Court upon due consideration of the premises do
order and appoint William McConnell, Peter McLaughlin
and John Stet to view the ground proposed for said road,
who after having been fully sworn or affirmed accordingly to
law to discharge the duties of their appointment with honesty,
are to go upon the premises where said road is proposed to
be located. And if all the said commissioners view the same
and a majority of them agree that there is occasion
for such road, they shall proceed to view and lay out the
same as equally to the wishes of the parties as may
be having respect to the best ground for a road and the
shortest distance and in such manner as shall do the
least injury to private property.

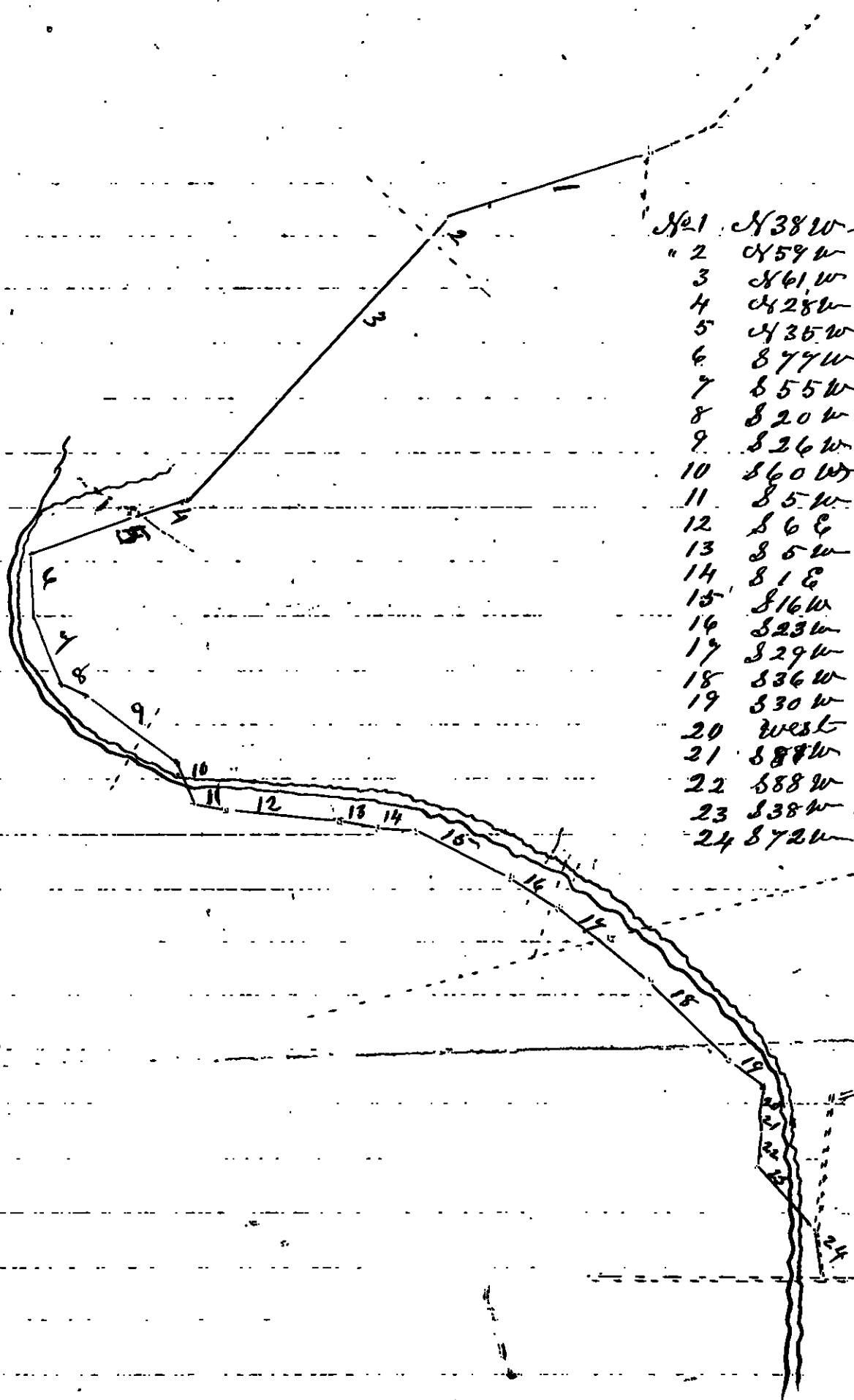
The persons interested in said road have firmly

Given public notice by printed or written ad.
Vincements of the time and place when such
Vincements shall meet for the purpose of discharging
the duties of their appointment, at least ten days before
such meeting.

If the Vincements aforesaid shall decide upon locating
and laying out said road, it is hereby made their
duty to obtain from the persons who own the land
it may pass Releases from any damages that
may arise to them from opening the same. And in
every case when the owners of such land refuse to release
their claim to damages, the said Vincements shall assess
the damages, and make a report thereof, signed by a
majority of their present, and transmit the same
together with all claims to the County Quarter Session
to be held in said office.

And the said Vincements shall make
reports of their proceedings herein to the next Court of
Quarter Sessions to be held for said County accompanied
the same with a Petition and draft of said road
with reference to the improvements that will be
made thereon. In which Report they shall state
what they have seen or ascertained, and also state
whether they judge the said road necessary for a
Public or Private Road.
