courses and distances of said Road to a
point on land of P. Robena thence
through Land of B. M. Bolgan North
thirty eight degrees west Eighty perches to a
post thence North fifty nine degrees west
three and one half perches to corner of
of P. B. Moyers and Heirs of Austin Thompson
thence by line between said Parties North
sixty one degrees west one hundred & eight
perches to post thence North twenty eight degrees
west sixteen perches to line between Bernard
Biglin & Charles Stewart thence by said line
North thirty five degrees west thirty two perches
to post thence By line of Biglin & Stewart
South seventy seven degrees west eighteen
perches to Birch thence South fifty five
degrees west twenty one and one half perche
to post thence South twenty one degrees
west eight perches to Bush thence North
twenty six degrees west thirty one

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions
held at Evansburg in said Co. on
the 9th day of November 1844, before the
Hon. Jno. Jones, of the same Court.

The Relation of this inhabitants of Washington Township and
parts adjacent in said Co. we present. Setting forth
that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a road
Beginning at a publick road leading from Main township.
Road on the lands of Warner Bender there by thence
and westwⁿ until it intersects a Publick Road leading
from Elizabethtown to Pottsgrove on the land of M. Bowles in said
township. And praying the Court to appoint persons to
view and lay out the same according to law.

The Court upon due consideration of the premises do
order and appoint William McCann, Peter McGehee
and John Stet to view the ground proposed by said Road,
who after having been first duly sworn or affred ready to
swear to do cheare the dates of their appointment will honestly
and truly go upon the premises where said road is proposed to
be located. And if all the said men view the same
and a major^t of them agree that there is occasion
for such road, to see fit to view and lay out the
same as equally to the wishes of the parties as may
be hereafter agreed to the best good for all roads and the
short distance and in such manner as shall do the
least injury to private property.

The persons intended in said road having timely

give publick Notice by printed or written Ad.
Vicinage of the time and place when such
Meets shall meet for the purpose of discharging
the duties of their Apparatus; at least ten days before
such meeting.

If the said Meets shall decide upon locating
and laying out said road, it is half made their
duty to obtain from the persons that own land
it may pass Releases from any damage that
may arise to them from opening the same. And in
every case when the owners of such land Refuse making
their claim to damages, the said Meets shall assess
the damages, and make Report thereof, signed by a
Majority of them present, and transmit the same
together with all claims to the County Court sessions
to be held in said office.

And the said Meets shall make
Report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of
County Sessions to be held in said County accompanied
therewith a Pet or Draft of said road
with reference to the improvements that will be
made. In which Report they shall state
that they have been seen or informed. and also state
whether they judge the said road necessary for a
Publick or Private Road.
