At a Court of General Quarter Sessions
of the Peace held at Ebocks for said
County on the 10. day of July A. D. 1874.

Before the Honorable John Dean Parrott and
John Managan and John D. Thomas Esqrs
Associate Judges.

The Petition of Peter Robinia Jr was presented
Representing that he labor under incumbrance for cost
of a road from his dwelling in Washington Tenn to
a point on the turnpike road leading from the
Village of Hornsboro to the Portage on the north
side of the Pennsylvania Rail Road on the
land of James Conrad about four hundred
yards west of said Conrad's dwelling house.
And therefore praying the Court to appoint
three persons qualified according to law to view the
place where said road is requested. And make
Report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter
Sessions.

The Court upon due consideration of the
premises do Order and appoint Henry Scanlan
John Kelly and Robert Menahan to view the
ground proposed for said road. Who, having first
given notice a proper notice of the time and place
of their meeting according to law. And have been
doing so ever or affirmed according to law to do so
the dates of their appointments with fidelity are to go

on the premises and proceed to view the same, and if all the said Viewers View the same, and a majority of them agree that there is occasion for such a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same as agreeably to the wish of the petitioners as may be having respect to the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property.

If the Viewers aforesaid shall decide in favor of locating said Road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the person through whose land the said Road passes, releases from any damages that may accrue to them in opening the same: and in every case where the owner of such lands refuses releasing their claims to damages, the said Viewers shall assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of the Viewers present, and transmit the same together with all releases to the next Court of Quarts Session to be held in this office with the papers relating to said Road.

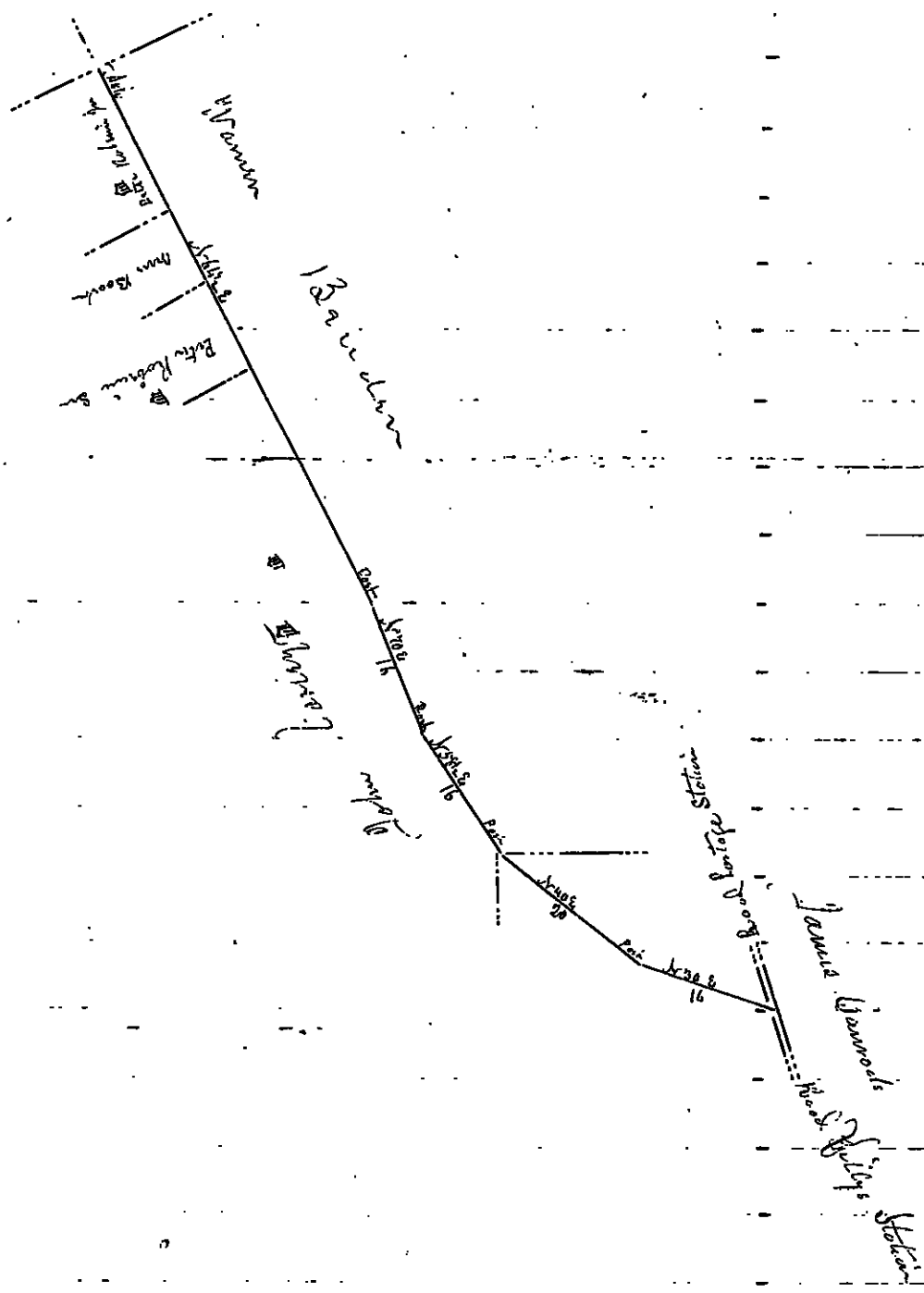
And the said Viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarts Session to be held for said County accompanying the same with a Plan or Map of said Road with the course and distance and reference to the improvements that shall be passed in which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed: and also, whether they judge the

Peter Robina for thence by line of land North Sixty four
and one half degrees East Sixty Eight perches to Post three
North Seventy degrees East Sixteen perches to Post three
Old log road North fifty Eight and one half degrees East Six-
teen perches Post then corner of land thence North forty degrees
East twenty perches Post thence North thirty degrees East Six-
teen perches to Point in public road leading from Postage to Kelly's
Station and Farm of James Caird. A copy of Notice is here-
unto annexed as well release for said road of Owners of
improved land over which road passes and in our Opinion
said private road is hereby See draft annexed
