At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of
the Peace held at Etnahwy for Cambria
County on the 3rd day of April A. D. 1844
before the Honorable Judge of the same Court.
The Petition of James inhabitants of Barr Township in said
County was presented. Representing that a road has been long
since laid out from a Point near John McDonald to
a point near the residence of Joseph Griffith, a portion of
which, being from a point at or near David Bunchers to
a point near Rakers Mill. petitioners conceive is now become
useless inconvenient and burdensome to the inhabitants
thereof, and therefore praying that the same may be vacated
and supplied according to the Act of General Assembly
in such case made and provided.

The Court upon due consideration of the premises
do order and appoint Henry Scanlan Henry Kromeracher
and Richard Gittings to view the road proposed to be vacated
and supplied who having been first duly sworn or
affirmed to discharge the duties of their appointment
with fidelity shall proceed to view vacate and supply the
same as agreeably to the wishes of the Petitioners as may
be, having respect to the best ground for a road and the
shortest distance, and in such manner as shall
do the least injury to private property.

The parties interested in said view having previously
given public notice by written or printed advertisements
of the time and place when said views shall meet.

for the purpose of Vacating and Supplying said road at least ten days before such meeting.

If the Meas. Affairs shall decide upon Vacating and Supplying said road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whom the road may pass releases from any damages that may arise to them in opening the same; and in any case when the owner of such land ^{refusing} their claim to damages, the said Meas. shall assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of them present. And transmit the same together with all releases to the Court of Quarter Sessions who has in said Court with the papers relating to said road.

And the said Meas. shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions who has for said County, accompanying the same with a Petition or Draft of said road with reference to the improvements through which it passes. In which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law. And also, whether they judge the same necessary for a Public or Private Road.
