

Ambria County ss.

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of  
the Peace held at Elmvale for Cambria  
County on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of April A. D. 1847  
before the Honorable Jno. of the same Court.

The Petition of this inhabitant of Barn Township in said  
County was presented. Representing that a road has been long  
since laid out from a Point near John McDonald to  
a point near the residence of George Griffith, a portion of  
which, bears him a point at or near Land Branches to  
a point near Barker's Mill. Petitioner concern is now become  
unless inconvenient and burdensome to the inhabitants  
thereof; and therefore prayeth that the same may be vacated  
and supplied. According to the Act of General Assembly  
in such case made and provided.

The Court upon due consideration of the premises  
do order and appoint Henry Scanlon Henry Stonemachan  
and Richard Gentry to view the said Road to Vacate  
and Supply. Who having been first duly sworn ex-  
afformed to discharge the duties of their appointment  
with fidelity shall proceed to view the said Road and Supply the  
same as agreeably to the wishes of the Petitioners as may  
be, having respect to the best good for all and the  
shortest distance, and in such manner as shall  
do the least injury to private property.

The parties interested in said view having previously  
given sufficient notice by written or printed advertisement  
of the time and place when said view shall meete

for the purpose of Vacating and Supplying Said road  
at least ten days before such meeting.

If the said Commissioners shall decide upon  
Vacating and Supplying Said road, to wit half make  
their duty to obtain from the persons by whom said  
the road may pass releases from any damages that may  
arise to them in opening the same; and in such case  
when the owners of such land refuse their claim to dam-  
ages, the said Commissioners shall assess the damages  
and make up the sum signified or one-half of them  
present. And transmit the same together with all  
releases to the Clerk of Courts Docket, to be filed in said  
Court with the papers relating to said road.

And the said Commissioners shall make  
report of this proceeding herein to the next Court of  
Sessions which meets for said County, accompanying  
the same with a Petition or Draft of said road with  
reference to the improvements thereon which it passes.  
In which report they shall state that the same is  
affid ready to law. And also, whether the said  
same may or may not be a Publick or Private Road.

to Indiana Count. on farm of Griffiths house &c  
thence North Eleven degrees East thirty nine perches thence North  
fifty eight and one half degrees West thirteen perches thence North  
twelve perches thence North twenty and one half degrees  
West fourteen perches thence North fifteen degrees East eight  
perches thence North two degrees West twelve perches thence  
North forty and one half degrees East twenty perches thence South  
fifty three and one half degrees East eighteen perches thence  
North twenty three and one half degree East fourteen perches  
thence North one half degree West twenty four perches thence  
South seven degrees East fourteen perches thence South  
one degree East twenty perches thence North twenty eight  
degrees West forty two degrees West perches three South  
one degree West twenty four perches thence North sixteen

and one half degrees West twenty eight perches three North  
four degrees East forty two perches three North one degree  
West fifteen perches thence North true and one half degrees  
West twenty two perches to Chestnut Stump in old road near  
John Beckers which said parts of said road we do  
vacate in consequence rough and swampy ground  
and Supply same as follows for a high way or public road  
viz Beginning at Chestnut Stump near John Beckers in road  
leading from McDonalds to Griffiths three South thirty  
and one half degrees West one hundred and thirty three  
perches to point in corner of land three South two and one  
half degrees West forty eight perches to Stone three South  
Twenty six degrees West Sixty Six perches Nine Three South  
Brown and one half degrees East Eighteen perches to point  
in public highway leading from Griffiths to Jas Grahams in  
Indiana County near Ad Barkers Sawmill  
all of said roads situated in Brown Townships  
all of which is respectfully submitted
