

To The Honorable The Judges of The Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria county:

We The undersigned,
persons appointed by your Honorable Court
^{as appears from} the annexed order of Court to perform the
duties therein mentioned do respectfully
report: That having given due and timely
notice, in accordance with the act of Assembly
of the time and place of meeting, we met
at the house of W. W. Harris Esq. in Jackson
Township at nine o'clock a. m. on Thursday
March 1st 1874, and after having been
duly affirmed to perform the duties of our
appointment with fidelity, we proceeded to
view the road mentioned in the said order of
Court as follows: Beginning at the residence
of W. W. Harris Esq. on the Johnstown road
thence north eighty nine degrees west fifty eight
perches, thence ~~north and east~~ south
thirty five degrees west forty four perches, thence
south sixty nine degrees west sixty eight perches
thence north nine and one half degrees west one
hundred and two perches thence north thirty
two west thirteen perches thence north forty
eight degrees west thirty six perches thence
north thirteen degrees west eighteen perches
thence north eighty two degrees west sixteen perches
thence south eighty three degrees west to the
upper Johnstown road, and we are of the opinion

that the same has become useless, inconvenient
and burdensome, and ought therefore to be vacated
we annex hereto a list or draft of the same.

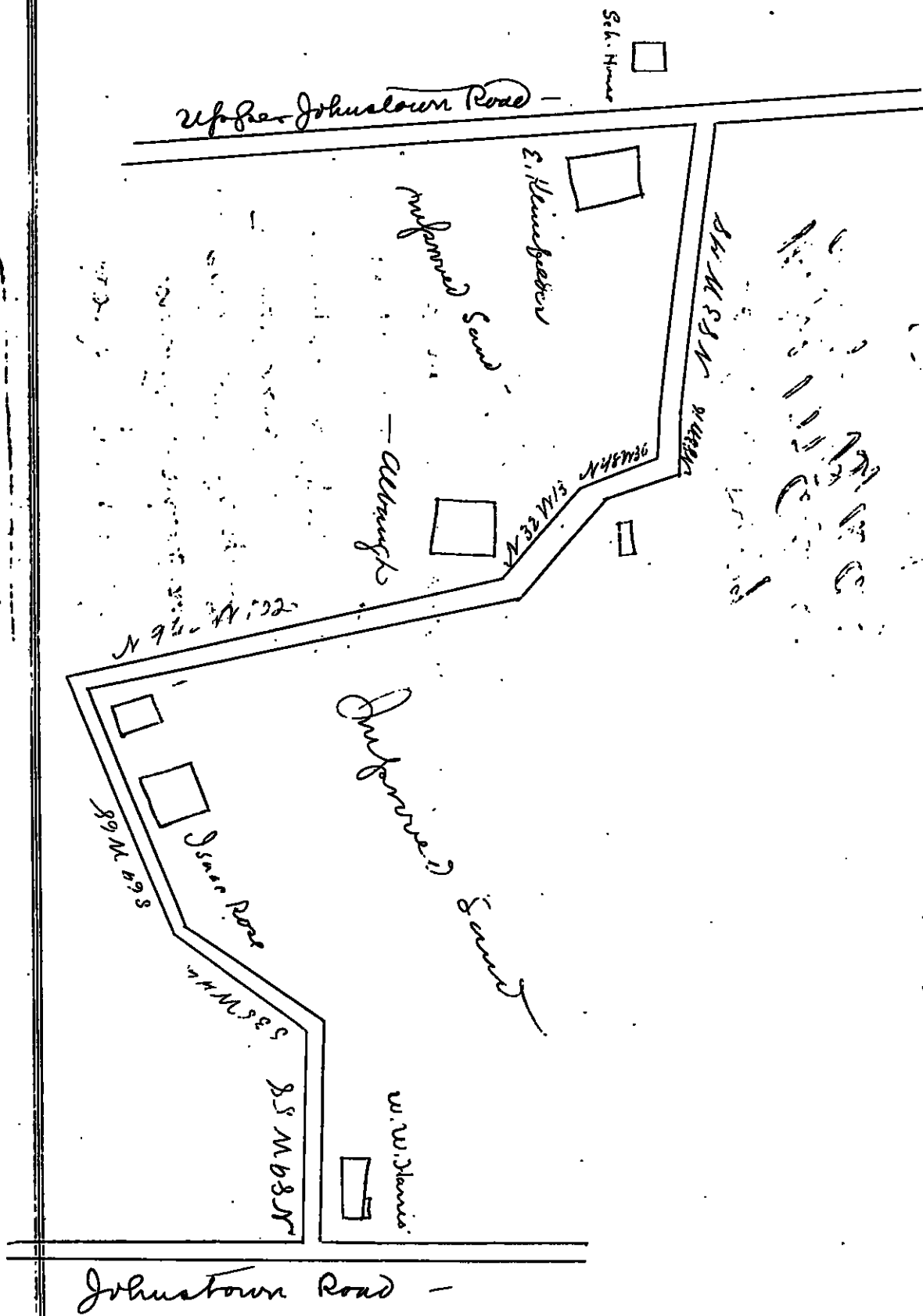

Cambridge County N.Y.

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions
held at Chenango for Cambridge County on
the fifth day of June A. D. 1876.
before the Honorable John Dean President
and Justices John Lloyd and John
Deane as Associate Judges.

The Petition of the inhabitants of Jackson Township in
said County was presented representing that a road has
long since been laid out from a point on Johnson
Road near W. W. Harris Esq to a point on upper Johnson
Road near Jacob Kleinfelters the road being about One
Mile in length. Where said the Petitioners claim has now
become in current use and has become. That there are
now two roads running parallel with said road one on
the north and one on the south both of which are within one
half mile of same. and both running between the two upper
Johnson Roads. And praying the Court to appoint
Justices to view the same and to view and vacate any
road described roads.

The Court upon due consideration had of the
premises do Order and appoint A. V. Barker, Henry Rager
and Andrew N. Jones to view the ground upon which said
road has been located. And if all the Justices appointed
view the same and a majority of them agree that there
is no occasion for such road they shall find
in Vacate the same. and make report of their
findings here to the next Court of Quarter Sessions.
