premises do order and appoint Henry Scanlan Esq.  
Jacob Kirkpatrick and Henry Blum to view the Road  
supposed to be vacated and suppld, who after having first  
been duly sworn or affirmed according to law to  
perform the duties of their appointment with fidelity, are  
to go upon the premises where said road is located and  
if all the Owners appointed view the same and a majority  
of them agree that there is occasion to vacate and supply  
said road they shall proceed to do so as aforesaid to  
the wishes as may be, having respect to the best good  
of a road and the shortest distance and in such  
manner as shall do the least injury to private property.

The persons interested in having said road vacated and supplied having previously given public notice by printed or written advertisements, of the time and place where said veins shall meet, for the purpose of vacating and supplying said road, at least ten days before such meeting.

If the veins aforesaid shall decide upon vacating and supplying said road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whom lands the part of the road supplied shall pass releases from any damages that may arise to them from opening the part supplied. And in every case where the owner of such land before releasing their claim to damages, the said veins shall assess the damage, if any, and make reports thereof signed by a majority of them present. And transmit the same together with all releases to the City Clerk's office, to be filed in said office.

And the said veins shall make Report of their proceedings hereon to the next City Clerk's office to be held for said City, accompanying the same with a Plat or Draft of the part of said road vacated and supplied, and the lines and distances, and references to the improvements that exist on the same at any time. And in such Report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed, and also, whether they judge the same necessary to a Public or Private Road.
