### Exceptions

- 1<sup>st</sup> The proceedings and report of viewers are erroneous  
and void because the order was issued at an  
adjourned sitting of the September Term 1881,  
(to wit, on 2<sup>nd</sup> November 1881) and the report was not  
filed to the next term, but on the 8<sup>th</sup> February  
1882, which was but the argument-court following  
the next term after the order was issued, which is  
insufficient, and erroneous.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> The proceedings are illegal and void because a  
report of viewers upon the same route had been set-  
aside, by the court, less than one year before the  
commencement of the proceedings for the present road.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> That the report is untenable and void because it  
reports "thirty dollars damages done to her impaired  
land", but does not name the person referred to,

Cambria County, ss:

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and for said County, on Wednesday the second day of November A.D. 1881 before the Honorable Judges of said Court: The petition of ~~some~~ citizens of Tusquehanna Township in said County was presented; setting forth, that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway; to lead from a point at the Indiana and Cambria County line at or near land of Mary Ann Boring, to intersect a Township road leading from St. Nicholas to Gammans Mills to a point at or near land of H. H. McGee, and praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint Henry Scanlan, Daniel Gammart and Arthur Reiger, to view the ground proposed for said road; who after having first given due and legal notice of the time and place of meeting, by printed or written advertisements, and having been duly qualified according to law, to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity; shall proceed to view the same; and if all the said Viewers view the same, and a majority of them agree that there is occasion for said road; they shall proceed to <sup>and lay out</sup> view the same, as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be; having respect to the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance; and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property. If the Viewers aforesaid decide in favor of locating said road; it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whose lands the road may pass, releases from any damages that may accrue to them from opening the same; and in every case, where the owners of such lands refuse releasing their claims for damage.

The said Viewers shall assess the damages, if any, and make report thereof, signed by a majority of the Viewers present, and transmit the same, together with all releases, to be filed with the papers relating to said road.

And the said Viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, accompanying the same with a plot or draft of said road, the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which said road may pass; In which report they shall state distinctly, that they had been sworn or affirmed according to law, and state further, whether they judge the same necessary for a Public or Private Road.





East thence by line of land of A. Schorn and James Anderson South  
two and one half degrees East Sixty two perches East thence through improved  
land of Abraham Hoven South Eighty six degrees East at thirty perches  
to a point on road leading from Adam Kriths to Germans Mills on land  
of H. H. Mc Bee all of said parcel being in Susquehanna Township which  
said view we do report for a Public road or highway in our opinion  
being necessary and advantageous to the citizens of Susquehanna Township  
and Traveling public And we do further report and award a  
sum of thirty dollars <sup>Sarah Collicy</sup> damages done to her improved land also a
