

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of
Quarter Sess of Carveria County Pa.

We, the undersigned, appointed by order of Court. to
review a part of a certain road laid ^{out} from ~~late~~ Nicholas
to Martin Munday. - ~~test~~ ^{to wit}, from the bridge over Blacklick
near William C. Smith, to a point near the residence of
Mrs Perquin. Notice having been given, and been duly
sworn according to law. Met at the place and time
named in the notice, viz; the 28. of February 1881, meeting at the Bridge
above named, We proceeded to view the ~~pts~~ ^{places} supplied and vac-
ated by former View. After due consideration and hearing
the desire of your petitioners and others - Make the following
report. To vacate all the supplies of former view. between
the points named in your order, which are two in number, the
one next to the bridge. is to near a line dividing the lands of
of two neighbors - the second supply has no better ground and
in our judgment the grade in some places heavier than the
ground of the original road and the expenses to open and grade
will be an unnecessary burthen on the people of the Township.
And substitute instead the ground of the original road as now
used, between the points named in the order. - Attached we give a

a draft with courses and distances. The single line
indicating the parts vacated. Beginning about six perches
South of the "Blacklick Bridge" and return the same
for public use.

At a Court of General Sessions of
the Peace held at Ebersburg, on Wednesday the
Eighth day of February A.D. 1882 before the
Honorable Judges of said Court:

The petition of sundry Citizens of Bar,
Blacklick and Jackson townships in said County was presented
setting forth; that a road has long since been laid out leading
from "Bethel" in Blacklick to Martin Munday's in Jackson township;
that at June Sessions 1879 of this Court upon the petition of certain
inhabitants of the above named townships Viewers were appointed
to lay out a road from St. Nicholas in Bar township to the last
above named point with power to vacate old roads, that said
Viewers vacated a portion of the above named road, to wit:
from the bridge over Blacklick near William C. Smith's to a
point near residence of Mrs. Pergain, and that they supplied
that portion by a road running between the said points;
said petitioners further represent, that the said new road as
supplied, is on a heavier grade than the old, that it is not
on as good ground, and that it has never been opened;
but that it would be burdensome and oppressive to open
the same; and further representing, that they are a majority
of the original petitioners for said road resident within the
County aforesaid, and therefore praying, that the portion
as above recited be vacated and annulled, and that for
that purpose the Court will appoint three persons to view
said road, or the ground where it has been laid out, and
supplicate and supply by a new road, or on the ground of the original road and
make report of their proceedings therein according to law.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises do
order and appoint William S. Lloyd, William Cyers and
Amos Rowland, to view the ground proposed to be vacated,
who after having first given due and legal notice of the time

and place of meeting by printed or written advertisements, and having been duly qualified according to law to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, shall proceed to view the same, and if ~~all~~ the said Viewers view the same, and a majority of them agree that there is occasion to vacate that part of said road; they shall proceed to vacate ^{and supply the same as aforesaid} the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be; and make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, together with a plot or draft of that ^{and the part supplied} part vacated, and references to the improvements through which the same passes: in which report they shall state distinctly, that they had been sworn or affirmed according to law.
