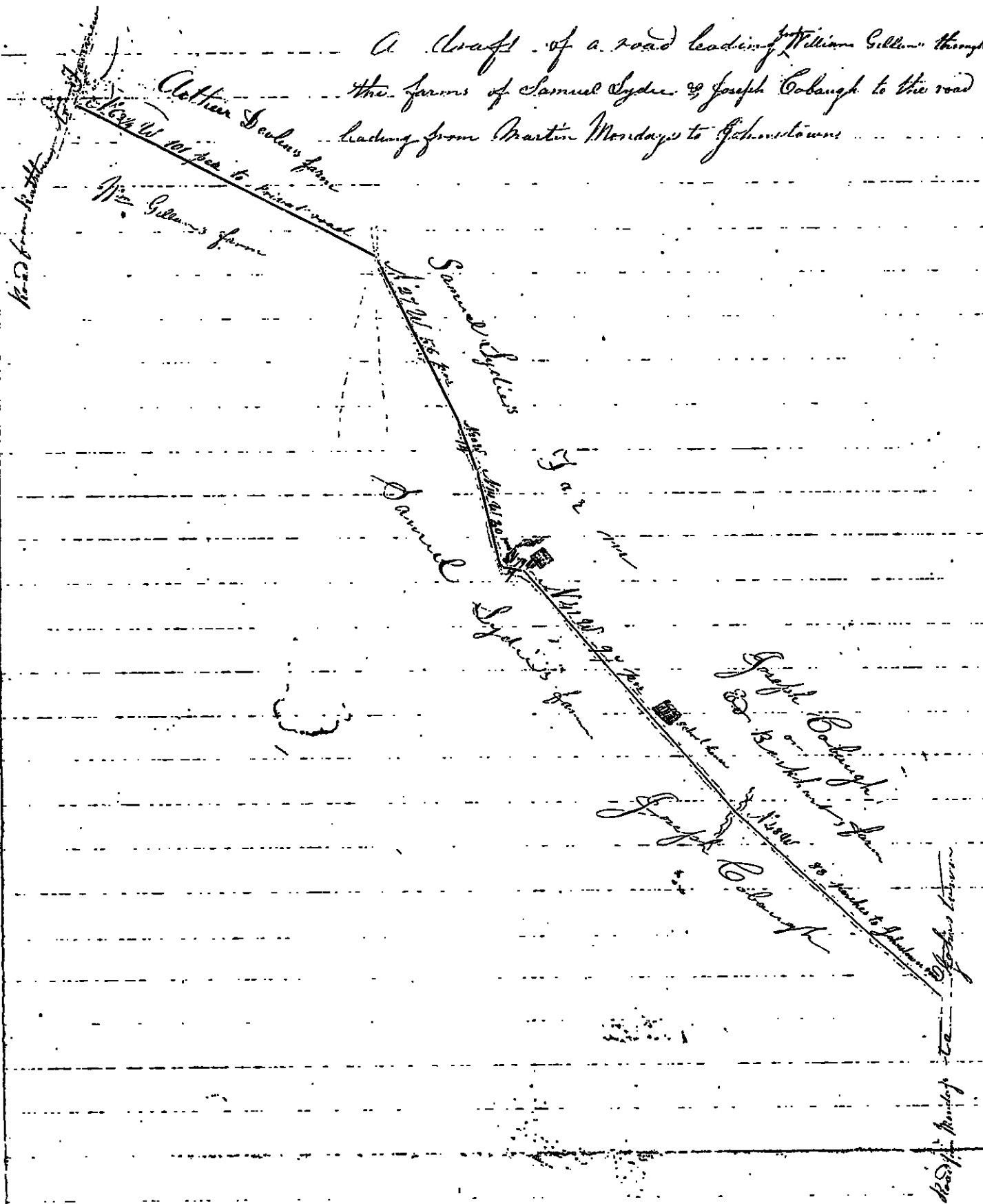


A draft of a road leading from William Gillman through

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Ebensburg in and for said County before the Honorable Judges of said Court. The petition of sundry Citizens of Jackson Township in said County was presented, representing, that they labor under great inconvenience for want of a Public Road or highway to lead from a point on the road leading from A. S. Rathbuni to Fairview, near the residence of William Gillow, to a point on the road leading from Martin Munday's to Johnstown, near the residence of Joseph Cobough in said Township and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, appointed William S. Lloyd, David Rorabaugh and George Page, to view the ground proposed for said road, ~~the, after first giving due~~ and legal notice by printed or written advertisements of the time and place of meeting, and, after being duly qualified according to law, to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity. Shall proceed to view the same, and if all of the said Viewers view the same, and a majority of them agree, that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect to the best ground, and the shortest distance, and in such a manner as to do the least injury to private property. If the Viewers aforesaid shall decide in favour of locating said road, it is hereby made their duty, to obtain from persons through whose lands the road may pass, releases from any damages that may accrue to them from opening the same, and in every case, where the owners of such lands refuse releasing their claims for damages, the said Viewers shall assess the damages, if any, and transmit the same, together with all releases, to be filed with the papers relating to said road; And the said Viewers shall make report of
