

Cambria County

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions
of the Peace held at Ebersburg in and for the
said County on the Twenty Eighth day of
March A. D. 1882 before the Honorable Judges
of said Court.

The petition of sundry citizens of Elder Township in said
County was presented representing that they labor under
great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway
to lead from a point at or near lands of Lewis Kline on pub-
lic road leading from D. Fritz to Santzys Mills. to a point
at or near School House No. 3. on land of Henry Abel to in-
tersect a public road leading from Carrolltown to Santzys
Mills in Elder Township said County praying the said Court
to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises ~~do~~
do order and appoint Henry Scanlan, Thomas Ott. and
Anthony Anna. to view the ground proposed for said road
who after having first given due and legal notice of the time
and place of meeting by printed or written advertisements, and
having been duly qualified according to law, to discharge the
duties of their appointment with fidelity, shall proceed to
view the same, and if a majority of them agree that there is
occasion for such road, they shall proceed to view and lay
out the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may
be having respect to the best ground for such road and the
shortest distance and in such a manner as to do the least
injury to private property; If the viewers shall decide in
favor of locating said road, it is hereby made their duty to
obtain from those persons through whose lands the road may
pass, releases for any damages that may accrue to them by
opening the same; and in every case when the owners of

such lands refuse releasing their claims for damages, the said viewers shall assess the damages, if any, and make report thereof signed by a majority of the viewers present, and transmit the same, together with all releases to be filed with the papers relating to said road, and the said viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County accompanying the same with a plot or draft of said road, the courses and distances, and reference to the improvements through which said road passes; in which report they shall state that they have been sworn or affirmed according to law and also whether they judge said road as laid out necessary for a Public or a Private Road.

Masters and John Schaeffer Esquire his
Associate Judges now Camping a Court of Quarter Ses-
sions and for the Peace in and for the County of Cambria
at June Term A.D. 1882

We the undersigned Jurors appointed
by the aforesaid Order of Court do report that we
gave due and timely notice by their advertisements posted
in their public places in Eldon Township of time and
place of meeting of Jurors and having met at time
and place designated by said notices after all being
first sworn according to law proceeded to the duties
of our appointment and did view lay out and mark
the following for a Public Road or highway. Beginning
at a Point on Township road leading from Smith's to
Lantz's Mills in Eldon Township all land of John Otto formerly
by Batzen Helfrich three South sixty two and one half degrees
East twenty six perches three North seventy five and one half
degrees East thirty three perches three partly by land of Philip
Miller and partly by land of John Otto North five degrees
East fifty two perches three through land of Philip Miller
North twenty six degrees East twelve perches by same land North
fifty degrees East ten perches three through improved land
of same North Eighty two and one half degrees East twenty
six perches three still continuing by same North fifty five
and one half degrees East thirty two perches to Point in Pub-
lic road leading from Bonalltown to Lantz's Mills all land of
Henry Able near School House No 3
