Report of Viewers filed 10th January 1882

To the Judges of the Court of Quarter
Sessions in the within or annexed Order

We two of the persons appointed by the Said

Court to view and lay out the road therein

mentioned do report that having first given

notice according to law of the time & place

of the View and having been duly affirmed

in the manner & form prescribed by the said

Order did view the ground for the proposed

road & have laid out and now return the

same for a public road beginning at

a point on a Public road leading from

Ulanville to Gills Bridge a short distance

east of Henry Hevrtly in Becaria Township

thence by line dividing lands of S Hegarty

rt to Hevrtly South 3° West 109 1/2 perches to

White Oak down. Thence by dividing line

of S Hegarty and Joseph Troxell lands

South four degrees West 92 perches to post
thence through land of Joseph Troxell
44 deg West 50 perches to a point on
County line near Joseph Troxell to be
intersected by road shortly to be laid
out in Cambria County - a plot or
draft whereof is hereto annexed
