

Camden County St.

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace
held at Ebersburg in and for said County on the
seventh day of August A. D. 1882 before the Honorable
Judges of the said Court the petition of sundry in-
habitants and the supervisors of the townships of
Carroll and Clearfield, in said County was presented setting forth
That a bridge is much wanted over Chest Creek at the place where
the public road or highway leading from Carroll town to St. Augustine
crosses the said Creek on the Township line between Carroll and
Clearfield on land of Brad Cassidy (near Martin's Mill) in said
County. The said line being frequently rendered impassible, by
reason of ice and high waters and that the expense of erecting
said bridge would be too heavy and burdensome upon the in-
habitants of said townships and praying the Court to appoint
proper persons to view the premises and take such order as the
subject as is required and directed by the Act of Assembly in
such case made and provided.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises
do order and appoint John Flick, Anthony Anna and
Henry Scanlan to view said premises who after having first
been duly qualified according to law, to discharge the duties
of their appointment with fidelity and to go upon the premises
and inquire whether it is necessary to build said bridge and
whether it would be too expensive for the townships of Carroll
and Clearfield to bear the cost of its erection, and make
report of their proceedings here in to the next Court of Quarter
Sessions to be held for said County; in which report they
shall state distinctly that they had been sworn or affirmed
according to law

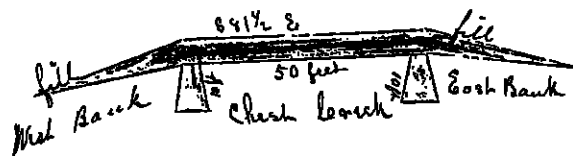

To the Honorable John Bean Esquire President Judge Joseph

composing a Court of Quarter Sessions and for the Peace in
and for the County of Cambria at September Term 1882

We the subscribers persons appointed by the Court to
view the place proposed for the bridge in the within order
mentioned respectfully report that we gave due and
timely notice of time and place of meeting of Jurors
by three written advertisements posted in public places
near bridge in Blairfield and Carroll Townships as well
written notice served upon Commissioners of Cambria County
Council of time and place of said view a copy of notice
being hereto annexed. And we do further report that
having met at time and place designated by said notices
and after all being first sworn to perform the duties
of our appointment ^{with} fidelity according to law we viewed the
present site of bridge and parts adjacent and are of opinion that
a bridge over Chest Creek at the place where the public high-way
from Carrolltown to Saint Augustine crosses the said Creek is necessary
and that the erecting of such a bridge would be attended with
more expence than it is reasonable the said Townships of Blair
field and Carroll should or can bear without involving said
Townships. Baring of location Beginning in present road on
West bank of Chest Creek on land of Ward and passing thence South
Eighty one and one half degrees East fifty feet Span buttments
ten feet in height not including foundation with two guard walls on
South side of bridge to protect buttments
