

1 To the Hon. the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions
2 of Cambria County,

3 The petition of the undersigned
4 Respectfully represents; That they labor under
5 inconvenience for want of a public road to begin
6 in a public road leading from Glendale to George
7 Walters, at a point on the division line between
8 the original surveys in the names of John Marshall
9 and Robert Barnhill, and from thence to lead along
10 the line between the said two surveys northwesterly
11 to the point where said line first intersects the
12 public road, about sixty rods from the said place
13 of beginning, in White Township,

14 The petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint three
15 viewers, qualified according to law, to view the ground
16 proposed for such road, and if they should see
17 occasion to lay out the same, to inquire of and
18 vacate the public road laid out beginning at
19 the public road leading from Glendale to George
20 Walters, at a point near the Beaver Valley United
21 Brethren Church, and from thence leading
22 along, near the line of the said two surveys
23 aforesaid of John Marshall and Robert Barnhill, to
24 the point above mentioned, in the
25 Township of White, which last mentioned road will,
26 by reason of the laying out of the proposed road become
27 useless, and make report of their proceedings to
28 the next Court,
