have viewed the same and that in our

and that the expense of erecting such a Bridge
would be attended with more costs than the
Township of Croyle could bear

2 At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of
3 the Peace held at Ebensburg, in and for said
4 County on Wednesday the sixth day of
5 September A.D. 1882, before the Honorable
6 Judges of said Court: The petition of sundry
7 Citizens of Croyle Township in said County was presented, setting
8 forth, That it is necessary that a bridge should be erected
9 over the Conemaugh River in said township, where the said
10 river crosses the public road leading from the Village of
11 Sumnerhill to the Village of South Fork, and that the
12 erecting of said bridge will require more expenses than it is
13 reasonable the said township of Croyle should bear; and
14 therefore praying the Court to appoint three persons qualified
15 according to law, to view the place proposed for said bridge,
16 and inquire whether such bridge is necessary and would be
17 too expensive for the said Township of Croyle to bear &c.

18 The Court upon due consideration had of the premises
19 appointed Augustine McConnell, Samuel T. Paul and
20 Joseph Croyle to view the place proposed for said bridge,
21 who after having first been duly sworn or affirmed according
22 to law to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity,
23 are to go upon the premises, and inquire whether said bridge
24 is necessary, and whether it would too expensive for said
25 Township to bear the cost of its erection; and make report of
26 their proceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions
27 to be held for said County: in which report they shall state
28 distinctly, that they had been sworn or affirmed according
29 to law.
