

Camden County N.J.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace  
held at Elkton in and for said County  
on the eight day of August A.D. 1887  
before the judges of the said Court the petition  
of Samuel P. Noel was presented setting  
forth that viewers appointed by this Court  
reported to March Term last, that they had laid out and  
returned for public use the following road viz: To lead from  
a point on the Glen's Run and Alltown Road on or  
near the line between Michael Shoben and William  
Lishart in White Township to the road leading from  
St. Augustine to McCane's Mill to intersect the road  
leading past Christ, Carlheims in Cheafeld Township.  
That said viewers have not in reporting said road  
obtained from Samuel P. Noel release of the damages  
in opening said road through his land, nor assessed  
to him the damages for opening the same and pray-  
ing the Court to appoint three persons qualified according  
to law to review the ground proposed for said road  
and assess the damages sustained by said Samuel P. Noel  
and make report &c. The Court upon due consideration  
had of the premises do order and appoint Peter J. Trepler  
John Bender & Augustine M. Connell to review the said  
road and assess damages &c. who after having given due  
and legal notice of the time and place of meeting and  
having been duly sworn according to law to discharge  
the duties of their appointment with fidelity are to view  
and adjudge the value of so much of the petitioner's lands as  
are taken up and occupied by said public road as located  
and are to take into consideration the advantages as well  
as the disadvantages which may have accrued or will ac-  
cure to the petitioner from the opening of said road and

1 assess to said petitioners whatever damage, if any, he  
2 may have sustained or will sustain from & by reason  
3 of the opening of said road. And make report of their  
4 proceedings. Return to the next Court of Quarter Session  
5 for said County in which report they shall state distinctly  
6 by that they were duly sworn & affirmed according  
7 to law.
