

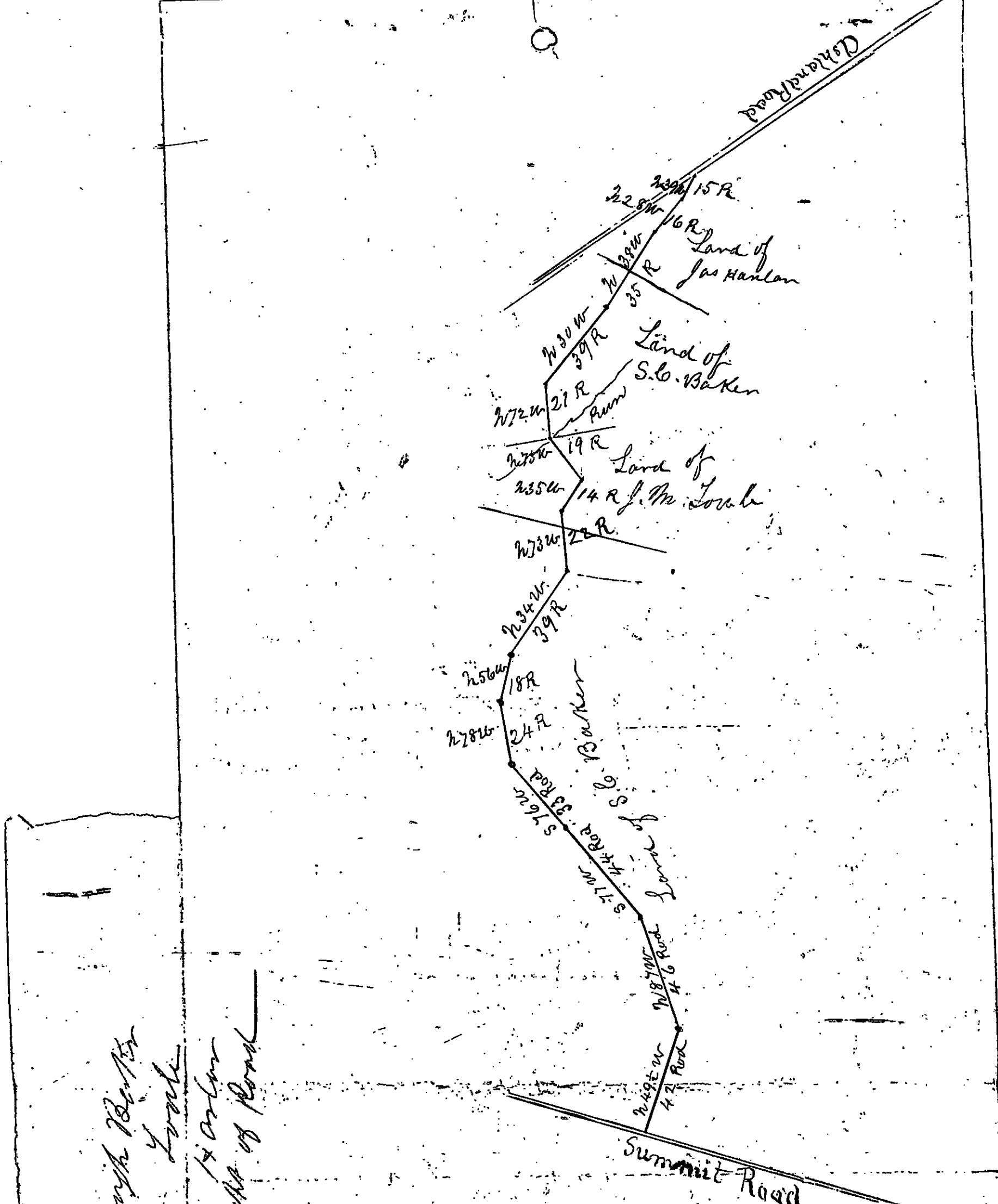
Columbia County N.Y.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace
held at Edenburg in and for the said County
on the 13th day of Nov. 1883 before the Hon-
orable Judges of the said Court the petition
of sundry inhabitants of Gallitzin Township
in said County was presented setting forth that a road had
long since been laid out from the Summit Road on the
property of S. C. Baker (formerly James Bunker) to the Ashland
and Gallitzin Road on the property of James Handman and
that said road has become useless inconvenient and
burthensome to the inhabitants thereabouts and pray-
ing the Court that the same might be vacated agreeably
to the Act of Assembly in such cases made and provided.

The Court upon due consideration had of the prem-
ises do order and appoint David Hunter, Bernard
Delaney & Richard Elder, to view the said road who
after having first given due said legal notice of the time and
place of meeting by printed or written advertisements and
having been duly qualified according to law to discharge
the duties of their appointment with fidelity shall pro-
ceed to view the same, and if all the said viewers view
the same and a majority of them agree that said
road has become useless inconvenient and burthensome to
the inhabitants thereabouts and the general public, they
shall proceed to vacate the same and make report of their pro-
ceedings herein to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held
in and for said County accompanying the same with a
draft or plot of said road vacated with reference to the im-
provements through which the same passes in which re-
port they shall state that they were duly sworn or af-
firmed.
