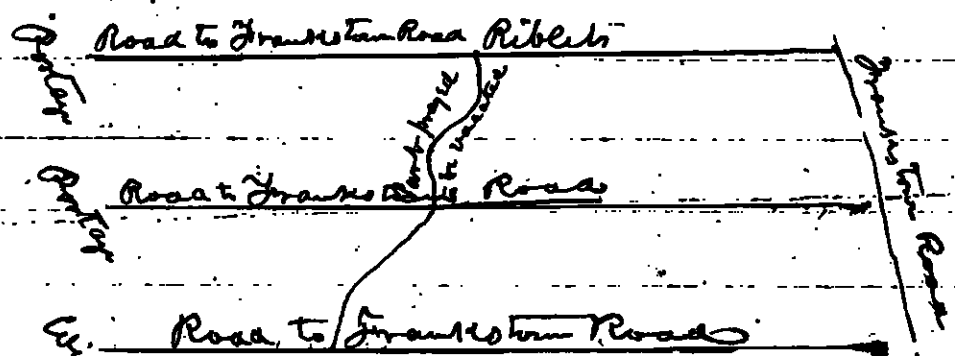


To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions

To the Honorable Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the peace in and for Cambria County State of Pennsylvania We the persons appointed by your Honors to view locate and survey a road running between two Roads leading from Portage to the Frankstown Road in Summerhill Township after having given ten days public notice of time and place of meeting and after being duly sworn according to Law Do Report - that in pursuance of said order we viewed said Road and the ground of proposed Road we are of the opinion that there is no necessity of any change in said road as we are of the opinion that it is on better ground and shorter distance than the proposed Route

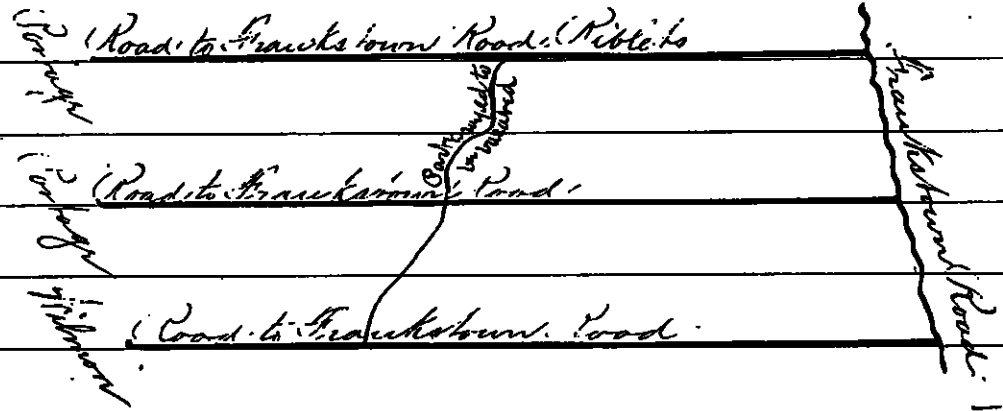

At a Court of General Quarter Sessions of the Peace held at Evesburg in and for said County on the Fourth day of August A.D. 1854. before the Honorable Judges of said Court: The petition of sundry citizens of Summerhill Township in said County was presented representing "That a road was formerly laid out from a public road leading from Milmore to the Frankstown road, to a public road leading from Portage to the Frankstown road, and crossing another public road leading from Portage to the Frankstown road as shown by the following plot:-



- The portion of said road lying between the two public roads leading from Portage to the Frankstown road (indicated in the above draft) your petitioners conceive has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome" and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view vacate and supply the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises did order and appoint Augustine M. Cornell, Philip Sherbine and Henry Coleman to view the ground

proposed to be vacated and supplied who after first giving due and legal notice of the time and place of meeting by printed or written advertisements and having been duly qualified according to law to discharge the duties of their appointment with fidelity, shall proceed to view the same and if a majority of them agree that there is occasion for said road to be vacated and supplied, they shall proceed to vacate and supply the same as agreeably to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect to the best ground and the shortest distance and in such manner as to do the least injury to private property. If the viewers of said road shall decide in favor of vacating and supplying said road, it is hereby made their duty to obtain from the persons through whose lands the supplied road may pass, releases from any damages that may accrue to them from opening the same, and in every case where the owners of such lands refuse releasing their claims for damages the said viewers shall assess the damages if any and make report thereof signed by a majority of the viewers present, and transmit the same together with all releases to be filed with the papers relating to said road. And the said viewers shall make report of their proceedings herein to the next court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace to be held for said County, accompanying the same with a plot or draft of such portions of road vacated and supplied, the courses and distances and reference to the improvements through which parts supplied may pass. In

which report, they shall state (that they had
been sworn or affirmed, and also whether they
judge the same for a public or private use
