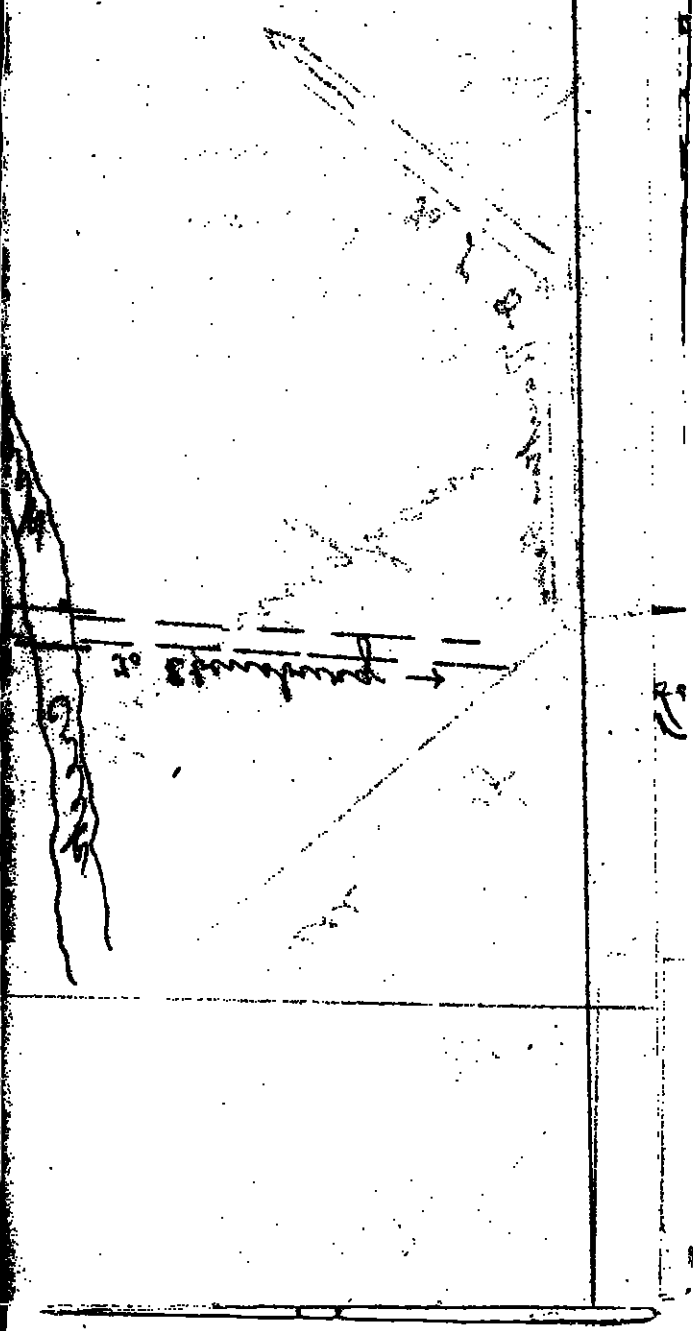
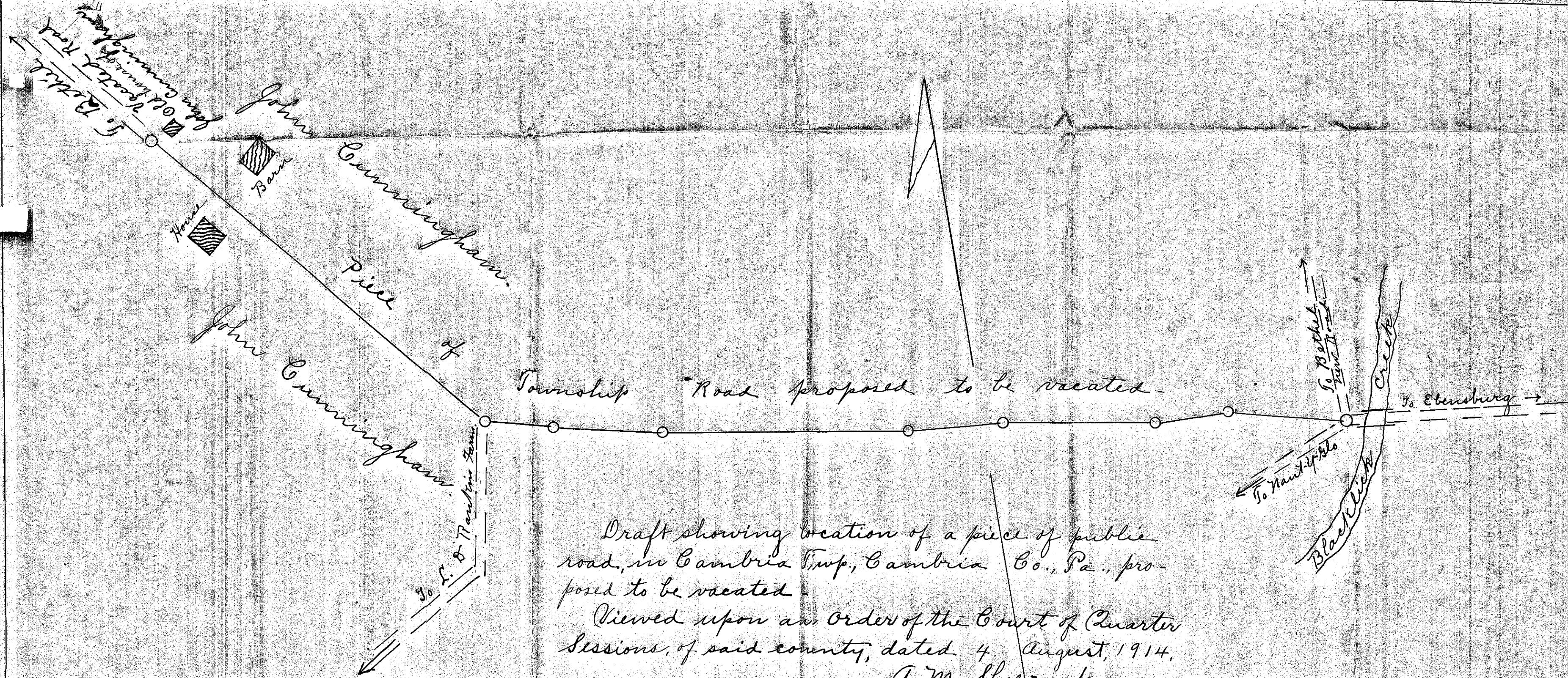

Now the condition of this obligation is such that in case the  
Court would direct that the cost of the view and proceedings in said  
case should not be paid by the County but be paid by the petitioners,  
and the said petitioners pay said costs, then this bond to be null  
and void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect.

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS  
OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

The petition of the undersigned citizens, taxpayers and residents of the Township of Cambria, in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, respectfully represent:-

That a public road long since laid out through Cambria Township, now known as the "John Cunningham" road, being part of an old road leading from Beulah, in Cambria Township, westward to Bethel, in Blacklick Township, beginning at a point in the road leading from Beulah to Bethel, 1027 feet west of the point where the Ebensburg and Blacklick branch of the Pennsylvania Railroad, near Beulah station, by an overhead bridge, crosses the Ebensburg and Vintondale road, which, at this point, follows the road leading from Beulah to Bethel, and extending along the road leading from Beulah to Bethel in a westerly direction 3240 feet, through and along land of John Cunningham, to a point in the road leading from Beulah to Bethel, at or near where the old house of John Cunningham stood; 4267 feet west of the above mentioned crossing, has become useless, inconvenient and burdensome to the inhabitants of the said Township of Cambria.

That a diligent search of the Road Docket failed to disclose the time or the session the above mentioned road was laid out.

Your petitioner therefore prays the Court that the said road may be vacated, agreeable to the Act of Assembly in such cases made and provided.

## R E P O R T   O F   V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your Honorable Court, upon the attached Order of Court, for the purposes therein specified, respectfully report:

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of Cambria Township, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached and to the public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the termini and along the route of the piece of road to be viewed.

All of us met in accordance with the notices so given, and having been first duly qualified according to law, to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment; we proceeded to view the piece of road referred to in the attached order and then adjourned to a later day to take whatever testimony the parties interested might have to offer, of which adjournment they had due notice, and accordingly we met in the Court House at Ebensburg and heard all the testimony relative to the matter in question, which the parties had to offer; and after carefully viewing the road and hearing and considering the testimony offered, We are of opinion that the road in question is not necessary for a public road and therefore should be vacated.

A plot or draft showing the location of the piece of road above referred to is hereto attached and made a part of this report, and shows the same to take the following courses and distances, viz:

Beginning at a point in the road leading from Beulah to Bethel, 1027 feet West of the point where the Ebensburg and Blacklick branch of the P.R.R. crosses the Ebensburg and Vintondale Road by an overhead bridge, near Beulah Station and extending thence North 76 1/4 degrees West 295 feet, West 177 feet, North 80 1/2 degrees West 384 feet, North 85 degrees West 233 feet, North 80 1/2 degrees West 611 feet, North 77 degrees West 275 feet, North 74 1/2 degrees West 176 feet and North 39 degrees West 1072 feet to a point in the road which formerly led from Beulah to Bethel, above referred to a portion of which has already been vacated; said point of ending being 4627 feet West of the above referred to crossing of the Ebensburg and Vintondale road by the Ebensburg and Blacklick Branch of the P.R.R: Said points of beginning and ending being more particularly described in the attached order of Court.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
