

#### REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county appointed by your honorable court, upon the attached order, and there in directed to view and determine as to the necessity for a public road in Blacklick township; between the points of beginning and ending particularly specified in said order; respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of Blacklick, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand billm posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the road to be viewed: and havin been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability; all of us met at the time and place appointed and having carefully viewed the premises are of the opinion that the piece of road asked for between the points of beginning and ending noted on the attached order of court is not necessary for public use.

The piece of road suggested to be laid out and viewed; a plot or draft of which is hereto attached and made a part of this report; takes the following courses and distances, viz:- Beginning in the road leading from Henry Campbell's to Duncan's Mill, at a point in said road 55 rods East of George's School House and running thence S.50½° West 1098 ft. said County, on the Fifth day of June A. D. 191 6, be-
fore the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township
of Blacklick, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under incon-
venience for want of aPublicroad or highway, to lead from
Beginning at a point in thepublic road leading from Henry Campbell's
to Duncan's Mill at a point fifty five rods east of the Georges
School House on said road, said point being six thousand five hundred
and eighty two feet from the place where the said road connects with
the road leading from Twin Rocks to Belsano and ending at a point at
or near the Post Office of Bracken in the said Township, which said
point at Bracken is seven thousand six hundred and ninety (7690)
feet west of intersection of said road with the Township road leading
from Twin Rocks to Pittsburgh Pike in the Township of Jackson.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according
to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint
A. M. Shoemaker, Esq., surveyor, and
J. D. Ritter and Adam Shuman
viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall
agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the
shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to
private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that
they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Scssions to be held for said County,
stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with
a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through
which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
