"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the necessity for a road in Croyle township, to begin on the South Fork Borough line, at the Northerly terminus of Wilson street, and to end on Luke street, in said township, as a point 650 feet Northward along said street from its juncture with Portage Avenue, in the Borough of South Fork; respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of the Township of Croyle, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminii of the proposed new road; having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the bestø of our judgment; all of us met at the place appointe in accordance with the notices so given and having carefully viewed the premises, are of the opinion that there is occasion and necessity for a public road between the points of beginning and ending above noted and as more particularly designated on the attashed order of court: Accordingly we proceeded to lay out a road between the terminii specified which would do the least injury to private property and be as near as practicable according to the desire of the petitioners, which said road as laid out takes the following courses and distances, viz: - Beginning at the South Fork Borough line at the Northerly terminus of Wilson street, thence North 19° West 112 feet, thence North 76° East 269 feet, thence North 62° East 230 feet, thence North 65 3/4° East 201.5 feet, thence North 43° 55' East 328 feet to the place of ending on Luke Street.
