The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of Croyle and Summerhill Townships, in said County, respectfully represents:

That your petitioners labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road or highway leading from the Township Road from Ebensburg to Wilmore to the Township Road from Ebensburg to Summerhill, near the Village of New Germany.

That the Eastern termini of the proposed road is found by beginning at the intersection of the Ebensburg and Wilmore Plank Road and the Road to O'Hara's Mill and from said intersection South twenty-five degrees East two hundred feet to a post; thence South fifteen degrees East two thousand five hundred and ninety-five feet to a post; thence South one degree West seven hundred feet to a post; thence South one and one-half degrees West two hundred and forty feet to a post; thence South nineteen degrees thirty minutes East two hundred and thirty-eight feet to a post; thence South five degrees East one hundred and forty-four feet to a post; thence South fifteen degrees fifteen minutes West two hundred and seventy-eight feet to a post; thence South sixteen degrees East one hundred and forty-five feet to a post, and thence South twenty-four degrees East four hundred and thirty-eight feet to a post at the Eastern termini of said proposed road, said termini being in Summerhill Township.



REPORT OF VIEWERS .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the Board of Viewers of Cambria Co., appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the necessity for a public road to lead from a point on the Ebensburg and Wilmore Plank Road, in Summerhill township, to a point on the Ebensburg and Summerhill road, in Croyle township, - said points of beginning and ending being more definitely specified on the petition of the inhabitants of said districts and on the order of court hereto attached - respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to the Supervisors of the townships of Summerhill and Croyle; by having them accept service of notices hereto attached; and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the proposed new road: and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability; all of us met at the time and place appointed, in accordance with the notices so given, and having carefully viewed the premises and the improvements through and over which the proposed new road would pass, are of the opinion that there is a necessity for a public road between the points of beginning and ending as specified in the attached order of court and accordingly we proceeded to lay out the same which takes the following courses and distances, viz:- Beginning on the Ebensburg and Wilmore plank road at the Easterly termini as specified in the order of court, and on line between lands of Paul Wuerfel and Jerome Noon, thence following on said property line thru uncleared land, North $84^{\circ} 14'$ West 2321 feet to a point at the corner of a field of said Wuerfel, thence thru uncleared land of Jerome Noon North $45^{\circ} 40'$ West 1842.5 feet to a point on a private road and corner of land of Mrs. Susan Motchenbaugh, thence along said private road between lands of Paul Wuerfel and Adam Motchenbaugh, Estate on the North and Mrs. Susan Motchenbaugh and Joseph Smith on the South at



NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land and such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
