

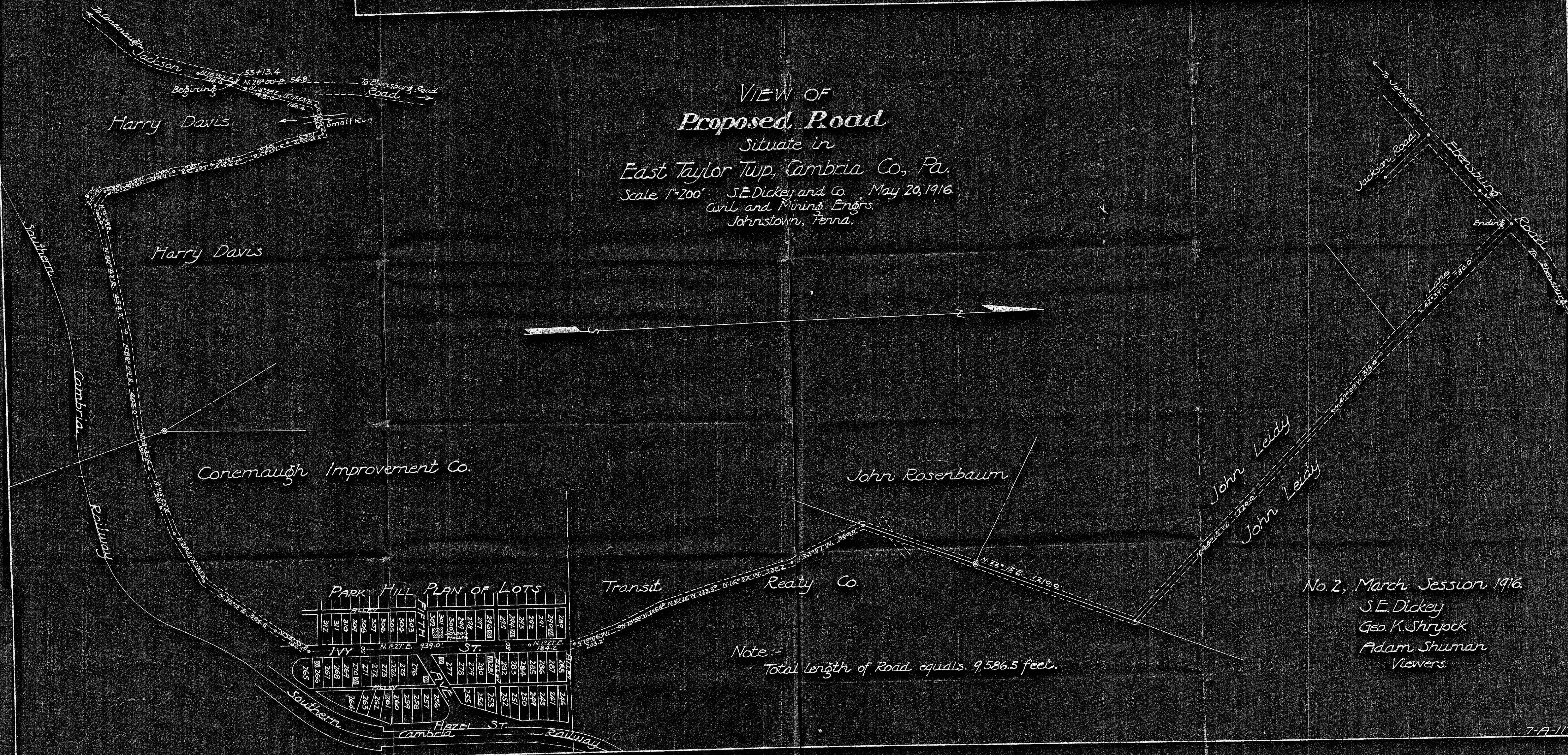

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, Daniel Link and John F. Dunmyer, of East Taylor Township, as principals, and Howard Davis and Harry Cooney, both of East Conemaugh, in the County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, as sureties, are jointly and severally held and firmly bound unto the County of Cambria in the sum of one hundred dollars, lawful money of the United States, to be paid to the said county of Cambria, its certain attorney or assigns; to which payment well and truly to be made and done, we do hereby bind ourselves, our heirs, executors and administrators, and every of them, firmly by these presents. Sealed with our seals and dated this 24th day of March, 1916.

Whereas, the said Daniel Link and John F. Dunmeyer, together with divers other citizens and taxpayers of the said Township of East Taylor, in said county, have presented their petition to the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, praying for viewers to view and lay out a public road or highway, beginning at a point on the Jackson Road, designated in said petition, thence by various courses and distances through the Park Hill Plan of Lots, and ending at a point on the Ebensburg Road, designated in said petition, in said Township.

The condition of this obligation is such, that if the above bounden, petitioners, shall pay or cause to be paid all costs and expenses incident to the appointment of viewers and laying-out said road, or that may be incurred if said road is refused, if the said court shall direct that they pay any part or all of said costs, then this obligation to be void; otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue.

R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter
Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We the undersigned Viewers appointed by the annexed order of the Court to view the road within mentioned respectfully report, that we have been duly sworn or affirmed as members of the permanent board of viewers as shown by the records of the Court, that having given due public notice of the said view and of the time and place of meeting by posting notices as required by the law along the route and termini of said proposed road and by service of such notices on the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of Conemaugh Township, acceptance of said notices by the Commissioners and Supervisors being hereto attached. We met in accordance with the notice given on the 5th day of May A. D. 1916 at 10:00 o'clock A. M. and proceeded with the duties of our appointment and viewed the premises and route of the proposed road and are of the opinion that there is an occasion for a public road as prayed for by the petitioners, and therefore we proceeded to lay out the same, having due respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as would be as near as practicable agreeable to the desire of the petitioners and at the same time do the least injury to private property, a plot or draft of said road as laid out by us is hereto attached and made a part of this report and herewith returned for public use, showing said road to take the following courses and distances.

BEGINNING at a point on the Jackson Road leading from Conemaugh to the Ebensburg Road at a distance of 5313.4 feet along the center line of said Jackson Road from its intersection with the Ebensburg Road as laid out by the State Highway Department, thence N. 28° 00' E. 54.8 feet, N. 15° 39' E. 148.0 feet, N. 17° 54' E. 156.4 feet, N. 79° 41' E. 121.3 feet, S. 10° 08' E. 153.3 feet, S. 16° 43' E. 109.8 feet, S. 5° 20' E. 121.0 feet, S. 6° 34' E. 159.0 feet, S. 10° 49' E. 104.9 feet, S. 15° 20' E. 100.0 feet, S. 11° 16' E. 100.0 feet, S. 52° 11' E. 70.8 feet, N. 73° 39' E. 100.0 feet, N. 80° 42' E. 454.2 feet, N. 86° 09' E. 403.0 feet, N. 78° 40' E. 180.5 feet, N. 71° 53' E. 291.6, N. 61° 08' E. 238.8 feet, N. 38° 15' E. 366.6 feet, N. 34° 33' E. 164.2 feet, N. 1° 27' E. 939.0 feet, N. 1° 27' E. 184.2 feet, N. 19° 06' W. 203.2 feet, N. 23° 59' W. 205.4 feet, N. 16° 26' W. 233.3 feet, N. 14° 32' W. 338.2 feet, N. 23° 57' W. 360.0 feet, N. 22° 15' E. 1210.0 feet, N. 44° 15' W. 1220.0 feet, N. 47° 00' W. 315.0 feet, N. 42° 39' W. 780.0 feet to the ending, said ending being in the center of the Ebensburg Road at a point 506.9 feet along the center line of said Ebensburg Road in a North-Easterly direction from the intersection of the Jackson Road aforesaid.

The plot or draft hereto attached shows the improvements and the owners of the adjacent property along the route of said road, said road as laid out will pass through or occupy land of the following: Harry Davis, Conemaugh Improvement Company, Transit Realty Company, John Rosenbaum and John Leidy. We obtained a release of damages from Harry Davis, same being hereto attached, and having failed to obtain a release of damages from the Conemaugh Improvement Company, Transit Realty Company, John Rosenbaum and John Leidy we assess them no benefits and no damages.

During the view of the ground proposed for said road several of the petitioners, two of the Supervisors and several owners of the ground affected by said road were present and heard and after due consideration of all the matters before us we are of the opinion that the road laid out by us is necessary for public use.

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed, third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."


