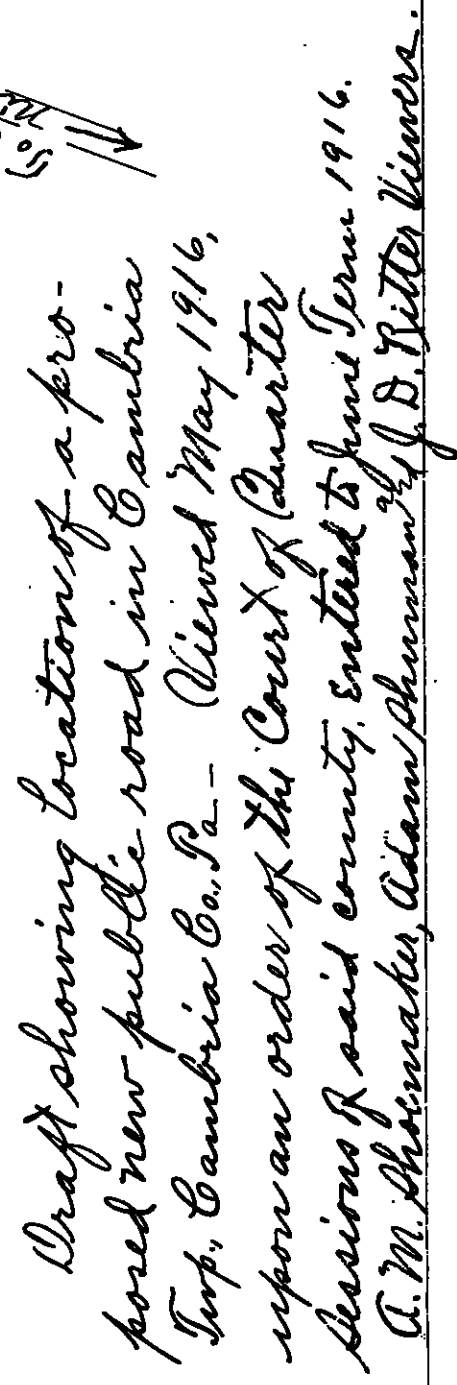

TO THE HONORABLE THE JUDGES OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS
IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CAMBRIA.

The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants of the Township
of Cambria, in said County, respectfully sheweth:

That your petitioners labor under great inconvenience for
want of a public road or highway in said Township of Cambria,
to begin at a certain point, which said point is on the Ebensburg
and Nicktown road, at a distance of 9072 feet southward along
said road from the intersection of the said Ebensburg and Nick-
town road with the public road leading from Bakerton to Nant-Y-Glo,
said point being at the juncture of the public road leading from
Colver with the said Ebensburg and Nicktown road, and ending on
the Ebensburg and Carrolltown plank road at a point 2864 feet
southward along said Ebensburg and Carrolltown plank road from
the Hermon School House, which is at the juncture of the cross-
road leading from the Ebensburg and Nicktown road to the Ebens-
burg and Carrolltown plank road, the same being about midway be-
tween Ebensburg and Carrolltown. There are no roads intersecting
the Ebensburg and Carrolltown road at any point on said road be-
tween Ebensburg and Carrolltown.

Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint proper
persons to view and lay out the same according to law.

REPORT OF VIEWERS .

To the Honorable, the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order, and therein directed to view and determine as to the necessity for a public road in Cambria Township, Cambria County; between the points of beginning and ending designated in said order; respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of Cambria Township, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the proposed new road; and having been duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability; all of us met at the time and place appointed, in accordance with the notices so given, and having carefully viewed the premises are of the opinion that there is occasion and necessity for a portion of the road asked for in the petition: which said portion is designated on the plot or draft hereto attached and made a part of this report, between the points marked "A". and "B". which begins on the Ebensburg and Nicktown road at the point of beginning specified in the attached order and ends on the cross road leading from the Ebensburg-Nicktown road to the Ebensburg and Carrolltown Plank Road; about midway between the points of beginning and ending specified in the attached order; the point of ending as specified in the order of court is designated on the draft by the letter "C".

The portion of the road really necessary for the convenience of the traveling public and as laid out and recommended takes the following courses and distances, viz:- Beginning on the Ebensburg and Nicktown road where the road from Colver adjoins same near the farm of John Griffith, thence along the Ebensburg and Nicktown road North 5° 50' West 426 feet to a private road which leads through and over lands of A. W. Bash,

thence following said private road South 64° 30' East 588 feet, thence South 87° 45' East 250 feet, thence South 64° East 349 feet, thence South 48° East 424 feet, thence South 51° 10' East 448 feet, thence South 68° East 370 feet, to the point to which the road is recommended to be opened, on the Cross road, thence, to locate the point of ending noted on the order, South 56° 30' East 2473 feet to the point on the Ebensburg and Carrolltown Plank Road.



At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the Second day of May A. D. 1916, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Cambria, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Public road or highway, to lead from a certain point, which said point is on the Ebensburg and Nicktown road, at a distance of 9072 feet southward along said road from the intersection of the said Ebensburg and Nicktown road with the public road leading from Bakerton to Nanty-Glo, said point being at the juncture of the public road leading from Colver with the said Ebensburg and Nicktown road, and ending on the Ebensburg and Carrolltown plank road at a point 2864 feet southward along said Ebensburg and Carrolltown plank road from the Hermon School House, which is at the juncture of the crossroad leading from the Ebensburg and Nicktown road to the Ebensburg and Carrolltown plank road, the same being about midway between Ebensburg and Carrolltown. There are no roads intersecting the Ebensburg and Carrolltown road at any point on said road between Ebensburg and Carrolltown.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
