

IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA.

TO THE HONORABLE, THE JUDGES OF SAID COURT:

The petition of the undersigned, residents and citizens of the Township of Cambria, in said County of Cambria and vicinity, respectfully represents:

That they labor under great inconvenience by reason of steep grades and sharp curves in that portion of the Public Road leading from the Borough of Ebensburg in Cambria County, Pennsylvania, to the Borough of Carrolltown in the County of Cambria, Pennsylvania, known as the Old Carrolltown Road, which portion of said Road they desire to vacate and have another road laid out in its stead.

They, therefore, pray that that part of the Public Road which leads from the Borough of Ebensburg, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, to the Borough of Carrolltown, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, known as the Old Carrolltown Road, should be vacated from a point which is located near the Lane leading to the George Davis Farm which is eight thousand eight hundred eighty-three and six hundredths (8883.06) feet from the point where said Road intersects Highland Avenue in the Borough of Ebensburg, to a point on the bend of the Road a short distance North of the Zoar School House, which said point is located eleven thousand one hundred ninety and ninety-six hundredths (11190.96) feet from the intersection of said Road with Highland Avenue in the Borough of Ebensburg, and two thousand three hundred and seven and nine tenths (2307.9) feet from the point of beginning first above mentioned, all of which portion of

said Road lies within the Township of Cambria and County of Cambria, Pennsylvania.

And, further pray that a new road be laid out between the said points above mentioned at a proper grade and curvature and thus eliminate the dangerous and inconvenient part of the present road.

They, therefore, pray that this Honorable Court appoint Viewers for vacating the Road for the purpose above specified.

REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating and supplying a certain piece of public road in Cambria township, between the points of beginning and ending specified in said order, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of Cambria township, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the piece of road to be viewed; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability:

All of us met at the time and place appointed and having carefully viewed the premises are of the opinion that the prayer of the petitioners should be granted and that the piece of road beginning at the southerly termini specified in the attached order and running thence along the present road the following courses and distances, viz. North 7° East 175 ft., North 00° 10' West 550 ft., North 1° 25' West 170 ft., North 40° 50' East 64.5 ft., North 51° 30' East 73.5 ft., North 16° 30' East 81 ft., North 13° West 124 ft., North 18° 10' East 63 ft., North 30° East 432 ft. and North 28° East 786 ft. to the northerly termini should be vacated and a piece of road taking the following courses and distances, viz. North 7° East 175 ft., North 00° 10' West 550 ft., North 1° 25' West 170 ft., North 3° 15' East 103 ft., North 13° 10' East 107 ft., North 26° 30' East 97 ft., North 29° East 74 ft., North 30° East 432 ft. and North 28° East 786 ft. should be supplied.

The piece of road recommended to be vacated takes the direction "A":
"B". "C". "D". "E".; as shown on the plot or draft hereto attached and
made a part of this report: and the piece of road recommended to be
supplied takes the direction "A". "B" "F". "D". "E". on the same draft.

Being of the opinion that no damage will be sustained by the owner of
the property over whose land the new piece of road is laid out, we have
assessed no damages. The piece of road recommended by the viewers to be
vacated is in their opinion very dangerous.

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg, in the said County, on the 17th day of September A. D. 191 7, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Cambria, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Public road or highway to be vacated and supplied, That they labor under great inconvenience by reason of steep grades and sharp curves in that portion of the Public road leading from the Borough of Ebensburg in Cambria County, Pennsylvania, to the Borough of Carrolltown in Cambria County, Pennsylvania, known as the Old Carrolltown Road, which portion of said road they desire to vacate and have another road laid out in its stead.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint:

A. M. Shoemaker Esq., surveyor, and

Adam Duman, J. D. Ritter

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
