The petition of the undersigned, inhabitants of the Township of East Carroll, in the county aforesaid, respectfully represents: That they labor under great inconvenience for want of a public road to begin at a point on public highway leading from Carrolltown to Patton 957.35 feet North of the intersection of the Patton- Carrolltown road with the road leading to Hastings, and to end at a point on the Hastings, Patton and Carrolltown ^{road} the distance of 656.7 feet East of the intersection of the Patton road with the Hastings and Carrolltown road, on the farm of William J. Hoover, in the said township of East Carroll. The petitioners therefore pray the court to appoint three persons, qualified according to law, to view the ground proposed for such road, and, if they see occasion to lay out the same, to inquire and vacate the public road now opened from the intersection of the Patton road with the Carrolltown- Hastings road, North therefrom on road leading to Patton, the distance of 957.35 feet, on the line of the proposed road in the Township of East Carroll, which said last mentioned road will, by reason of the laying out of the proposed road, become useless; and make report of their proceedings to next court. 

Airhart, all of the Township of East Carroll, Cambria County and State of Pennsylvania, are held and firmly bound unto the Commissioners of the County of Cambria, for use of the County of Cambria, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, their successors or assigns, in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, lawful money, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we do bind ourselves, our and each of our heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

Sealed with our seals and dated the 11th., day of March, A.D. 1919.

Whereas, the above named obligors, along with others, have presented a petition to the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania, for the appointment of viewers to view and lay out a certain public highway in the Township of East Carroll, on the Patton Carrolltown road, beginning at a point on said road 957.35 feet north of the intersection of the Patton road with the Carrolltown and Hastings road, and extending to a point East of the intersection of the Patton road with the Hastings and Carrolltown road the distance of 656.7 feet from the intersections of said highways, and to vacate the public road now opened from the intersection of the Patton road with the Carrolltown- Hastings road, North therefrom on road leading to Patton, the distance of 957.35 feet to the line of the proposed road.

REPORT OF VIEWERS .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the propriety of vacating and supplying a certain piece of public road in East Carroll township, said county and state, between the points of beginning and ending specified in said order, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the Supervisors of East Carroll township by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the piece of road to be viewed; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: All of us met at the time and place appointed in accordance with the notices given and having carefully viewed the premises we are unanimously of the opinion that the prayer of the petitioners should be granted and that the piece of road beginning at the Hastings - Chest Springs road, which is also on the Carrolltown - Patton road, and extending thence North sixty five degrees thirty minutes East along the Carrolltown-Patton road for nine hundred fifty seven and thirty five one hundredths feet to a point opposite the lane leading to the farm of William J. Hoover, should be vacated and that a piece of road beginning at a point on the same Hastings-Chest Springs and Carrolltown-Patton road at a point more definitely specified in the attached order as six hundred fifty six and seven tenth feet East of the point of intersection of the Patton-Carrolltown road with the Hastings-Chest Springs road where the said Carrolltown-Patton road meets the Hastings-Chest Springs road near the farm of William J. Hoover and extending thence North twenty eight degrees twenty minutes West ten hundred forty two feet across land of

said William J. Hoover to a point on the said Carrolltown-Patton road near the end of the lane on said Hoover farm should be supplied.

A plot or draft showing the location and the courses and distances of the piece of road recommended to be vacated and the piece of road recommended to be supplied is hereto attached and made a part of this report.

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
