R E P O R T O F V I E W E R S .

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order and therein directed to view and determine as to the necessity for a public road in Portage township, said county and state, between the termini specified in said order, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria county and the Supervisors of Portage township, by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the terminal points of the proposed road; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: all of us met at the time and place appointed in accord with the notices so given and having carefully viewed the premises are all of the opinion that the road as petitioned for is necessary.

A plot or draft showing the location of the road as laid out is hereto attached and made a part of this report. Said road as laid out takes the following courses and distances, viz: Beginning on the public road leading from Portage to the Frankstown road at the farm of Mike Yetsko, and running thence North 84° West 746 ft. across land of said Yetsko and John Shaffranck to line of land of C. W. Anderson, thence across land of said Anderson and along line of land of Samuel Finacy, James Sheridan, the Martin Realty Co. and John Timura South 62° 45' West 2446 ft. to line of land of Joshua Riblett, thence across land of said Riblett North 82° 30' West 796 ft. to the public road leading from Portage to the Frankstown road. Said points of beginning and ending above referred to being the same as are specified in the attached order.

Having failed to secure releases of damages from Mike Yetsko and Joshua Riblett we have estimated the damages sustained by Mike Yetsko at thirty five dollars and the damages sustained by Joshua Riblett at

seventy five dollars.

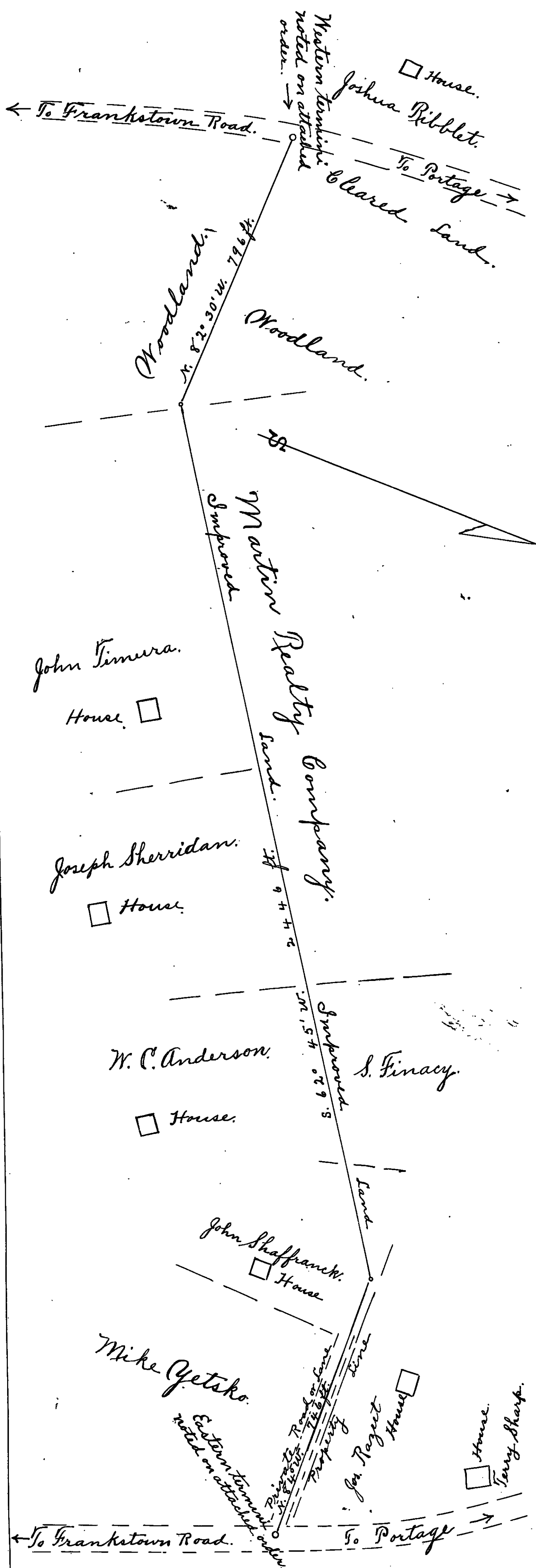

D. 191 9, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Portage, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Public road or highway, to lead from a point on the public road leading from Beaverdale to Portage at land of Joshua Riblett, distant 2640 feet in a Northerly direction from the intersection of said Public Road with the Frankstown Road, in the Township of Portage, and ending at a point on another road public road leading from the Frankstown ^{Road} to Portage, at a common corner of lands of Joseph Razut, Martin Realty Company, and Mike Yetsko, distant 3356 feet in a Northerly direction from the intersection of said other public road with the Frankstown Road in the Township of Portage.

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground; and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
