## REPORT OF VIEWERS.

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of  
Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable Court, upon the attached order, to view the site for a proposed new bridge over Ben's Creek, on the road leading from Lilly to Portage; by way of the Village of Ben's Creek; in Washington township, Cambria county, Pennsylvania, respectfully report:-

That; having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers, to the Commissioners of Cambria county and the Supervisors of the township of Washington by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the traveling public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the site of the proposed new bridge; and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability the two of us met in accordance with the notices so given, ( J.D.Ritter not appearing ), and having carefully viewed the premises, investigated and inquired into the necessity for a new and more substantial bridge over the Ben's Creek at the place designated in said order and are of the opinion that a new and more permanent bridge for the accomodation and safety of the traveling public is necessary at the place above mentioned and are of the opinion further that the expense of constructing the same is more than is reasonable the taxpayers of the township should be required to bear and therefore recommend that the expense of constructing the same be borne by the county of Cambria.

A plot or draft showing the location and size of the new bridge as recommended is hereto attached and made a part of this report.

Said proposed new bridge should, in our opinion, be built approximately two and one half feet higher than the present old bridge.

D. 191 9, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Washington, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a Bridge ~~road, leading from~~ over Benscreek, at the place where the public highway, leading from Portage Borough to Lilly Borough in the Township aforesaid, where said Public road crosses said Bens Creek in Washington Township aforesaid. That the present bridge at said place, has become out of repair and unsafe to some extent to travel on. That the expense of erecting said bridge would be too heavy and burdensome upon the inhabitants and tax payers of said Township.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court, upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

viewers, to view the ground proposed for said ~~road~~ <sup>bridge</sup> and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such ~~road~~ <sup>bridge</sup>, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the ~~road~~ <sup>bridge</sup> shortest distance and the best ground for a ~~road~~ <sup>bridge</sup>, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a ~~public or private road~~ <sup>bridge</sup>, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

We, the undersigned members of the Permanent Board of Viewers of Cambria County, appointed by your honorable Court upon the attached order, to view and inspect a certain bridge over ~~the~~ Ben's Creek on the road leading from Portage to Lilly, in Washington township, Cambria county, Pennsylvania, respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and to Trimpey & Whipkey, the contractors, and having been each duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability :All of us met at the site of the above referred to bridge and having gone over and enquired into the details of the construction and investigated as to the workmanship thereof and find the same to have been completed in a good workmanlike manner and according to the plans and specifications and accordingly we recommend that the balance of the contract price, viz \$399.76, plus \$136.00. for eleven and three fourths yards of masonry at \$12.00 per yard and an additional 544 sq. ft wire mash at three cents a sq. ft. or \$16.32. making a total balance of five hundred fifty two & 8/100 ( \$552.08 ) dollars, to be paid by the Commissioners of Cambria County to Trimpey & Whipkey, the contractors.



THEREFORE be it resolved and it is hereby resolved by and with the authority of the Board of Township Supervisors of Upper Yoder Township, Cambria County, Pennsylvania, in accordance with the Act of Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania approved the 20th day of April, 1874, and the amendments thereof and supplements thereto as follows:

SECTION I: - That the corporate authorities of the said Township of Upper Yoder hereby signify and express their desire to increase the bonded indebtedness of the said Township by the amount of One Hundred Seventy-five Thousand (175,000) Dollars, or 5.52 (plus) per centum of the last assessed valuation of the taxable property therein, for the purpose of reconstructing the Millcreek Road, extending from the boundary line of the said Township of Upper Yoder and the Borough of Westmont in said Cambria County, westwardly to the Ligonier Pike in said Township; provided that before the desire herein signified and expressed be carried out that the assent of the electors of the said Township be obtained in the manner provided by law and this resolution.

RESOLUTION

A resolution signifying and expressing the desire of the corporate authorities of the Township of Upper Yoder, County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania, to increase the bonded indebtedness of said Township by the amount of One Hundred Seventy-five Thousand (175,000) Dollars, or 5.52 (plus) per centum of the last assessed valuation of the taxable property therein for the purpose of reconstructing Millcreek Road, extending from the boundary line of the said Township of Upper Yoder and the Borough of Westmont in said Cambria County, westwardly to the Ligonier Pike in said Township, with the assistance of said Cambria County, and authorizing a public election for the purpose of obtaining the assent of the electors of said Township to such increase of indebtedness and giving notice thereof;
