NOTE. "It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly. First, who of them were present at the view, second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."

REPORT OF VIEWERS

To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court of Quarter Sessions of Cambria County, Pennsylvania.

We, the undersigned members of the board of viewers of Cambria county, appointed by your honorable Court, upon the attached order, to view the site for a proposed new bridge over the Little Conemaugh River, where Church Street crossed same in the Borough of Lilly, said county and state; respectfully report:-

That having given due notice of the view and of the time and place of meeting of the viewers to the Commissioners of Cambria County and the borough council by having them accept service of notices hereto attached, and to the public by printed hand bills posted in public and conspicuous places at and near the site of the proposed bridge: and having been first duly qualified according to law to perform the duties of our appointment faithfully, impartially and to the best of our judgment and ability: All of us met, in accord with the notices so given, at the site of the proposed bridge and having carefully viewed the premises, inspected the old bridge, investigated and inquired into the necessity for a new and more substantial bridge over the Little Conemaugh River at the point above indicated and are all of the opinion that a new and more permanent and more modern bridge over the Little Conemaugh River where the same is crossed by Church Street in the Borough of Lilly is necessary.

The viewers are of the opinion that the cost of constructing the proposed bridge would be more than is reasonable the Borough of Lilly should be required to bear alone and therefore recommend that the County of Cambria should bear two thirds and the Borough of Lilly-one-third of the cost of constructing the new bridge which we beg leave to suggest should be twenty four feet long and twenty four feet wide with center line of the the/Westerly end of the new bridge fourteen feet and the center line of the Easterly end of the new bridge twenty feet farther South than the center line of the present old bridge and that the new bridge should be approximately four feet higher than the old one, and have a six foot walk for pedestrians on the Northerly side with an eighteen foot driveway to the Southerly side of same.

A plot or draft showing the location of the present old bridge and the size and location of the new bridge as recommended, is hereto attached and made a part of this report.
