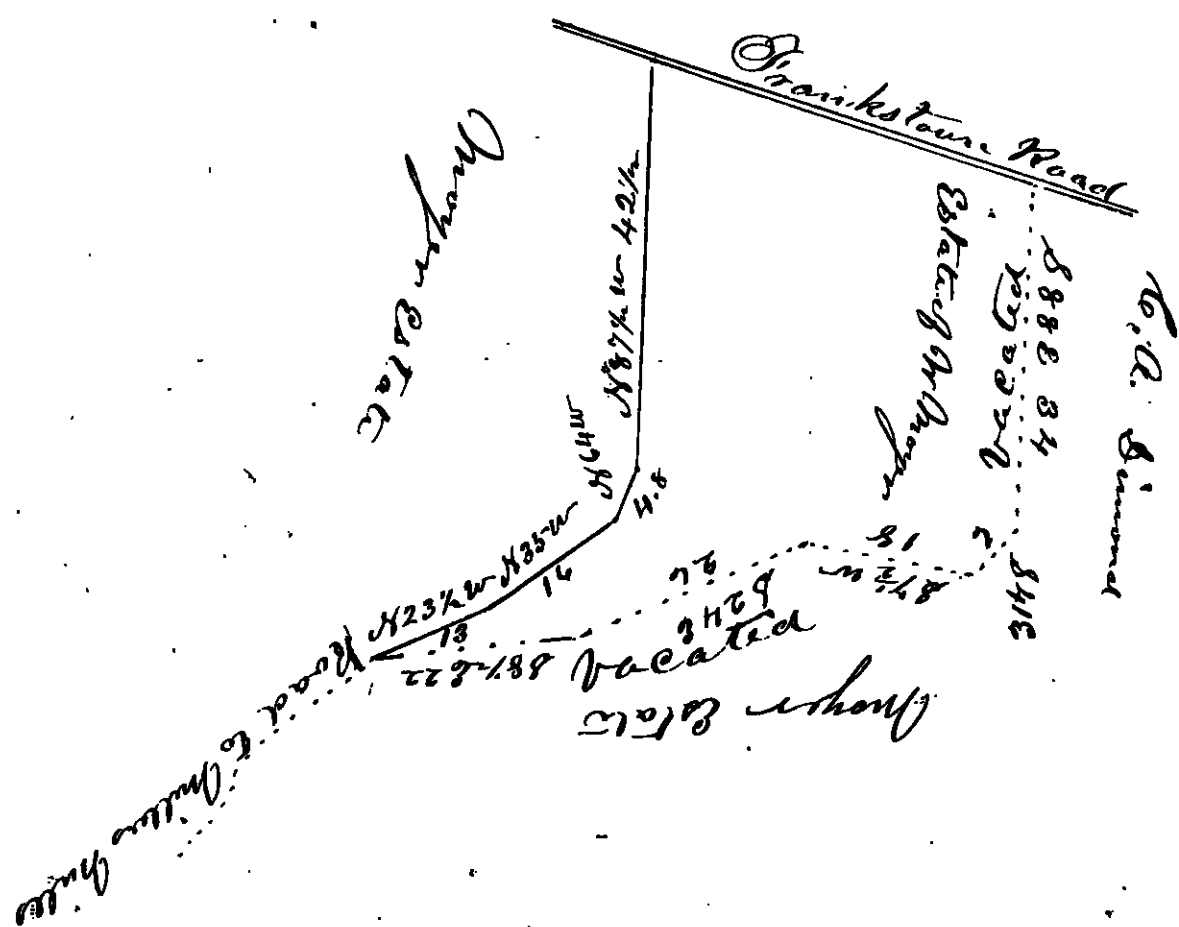

which it may pass.
