To the Honorable, the Judges of the Court
of Quarter Sessions of ~~Common Pleas~~ of Cambria County.

The petition of the Commissioners of
Cambria County respectfully represents:
That it having appeared to the Court, to the
Grand Jury and to the Commissioners of Cambria
County, that a bridge over the Conemaugh
River in Croyle Township, between Summerhill
and South Fork ——— was necessary, and
that it would be too expensive for the Township
of Croyle, in which said bridge is sit-
uated, to erect said bridge; and the same
having been entered of record, your petition-
ers procured an estimate to be made, as
nearly as might be, of the expense of the
same, amounting to \$1208⁴⁸, and did proceed
to have said bridge erected by entering into
contract with The Morse Bridge Company
for the building of the same; and that the same
is now ^{about} completed. Your petitioners therefore
pray the Court to appoint six fit persons to
inspect said bridge, and the workmanship thereof,
agreeably to the Act of Assembly, and to make report
thereof to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held
for said County.
