At a court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria
held at Ebensburg in the said County, on the ninth day of
December A. D. 1856, before the Honorable the Judges of the same
court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the township of West Taylor
in the said county, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a
road or highway, to lead from a publick road beginning at the State line on the old
Pennsylvania Canal near H. J. Griffiths and extending to the line of Cambria County and Indiana County
and sometimes called the Old State Road, was laid out
by order of this Court and that a part of the same in
its present location has become inconvenient and
would better accommodate the publick by being changed
so as to begin and end at the same point but leaving
the present road at the South Easterly line of Daniel
McLaughlin's land (where said line crosses said road)
and thence by nearest and best route to Indiana
County line at farm formerly of Ekelar and now
belonging to Pekos.

same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do
order and appoint, Harry S Peeler SURVEYOR,
and John Stumbaugh, and George Ribblett

~~Change~~ VIEWERS, to view the ground proposed for said
road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such
~~road~~, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance
and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to
private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the
petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court
of Quarter Sessions to be held for said county, stating particularly whether they
judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft
thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through
which it may pass.

who after being duly sworn, Do Report that we have
viewed that part of said road from the South Easterly
line of Daniel McLaughlin land where it crosses said
road to the Indiana county line that it is inconvenient
and burthenome to the traveling public. Therefore we do
vacate the same, And view, and lay out a road Public
use in lieu of the same. Beginning at the line of
