An Ordinance extending Locust Street from its present termination to Rail Road Street

Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgesses and Town Council of the Borough of East Cenemagh and it is hereby ordained and enacted by authority of the same That Locust Street in the said Borough of Cenemagh be and hereby is extended from its present termination on Alley to Rail Read Street the Westerly line of said extension of street to be a continuation of the western line of said Locust Street as at present established and the Easterly line of said extension to be a continuation of the Easterly line of said Street as at present established

Sec 11. That all ordinances relating to Streets in said Borough be extended to and over said Locust Street as extended



Eighty Five dollars (\$85.00), being an assessment for contribution and the amount of the advantages to said property over and above all disadvantages.

And the remainder or balance of said damages to wit Five hundred and forty dollar and Eight cents (\$540.08) we assess and charge against the Borough of East Conemaugh by reason of the general benefit to said Borough from the opening of said extension of said ditch.

And as to any other property along said extension we further Report that the advantages and disadvantages are equal and balance each other, and we make no assessment or allowance for either damage or contribution.





held at Ebensburg in and  
for the County of Cambria on  
Monday the second day of  
December A.D. 1889. the  
Petition of Robert Biggs,  
Burgess of East Conemaugh Bur-  
ough was presented setting forth that the Town Council  
of the Borough of East Conemaugh on the 7th day of November  
A.D. 1889 adopted an ordinance a copy of which is attached  
to this laying out an extension of Locust Street from its  
present terminus to Rail Road Street in the said Bur-  
ough. Copy of Ordinance = "Be it ordained and enacted  
by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of  
East Conemaugh and it is hereby ordained and en-  
acted by authority of the same that Locust Street in  
the said Borough of Conemaugh be and hereby is ex-  
tended from its present termination on Alley to Rail  
Road Street the Westward line of said extension of street  
to be a continuation of the Westward line of said Locust  
Street as at present established and the Eastward line of  
said extension to be a continuation of the Eastward line  
of said street as at present established. Sec. II. That  
all ordinances relating to streets in said Borough be  
extended to and over said Locust Street as extended.  
The said Petitioner pray your Honorable Court to ap-  
point seven disinterested freeholders of said Borough  
who after being duly sworn according law shall pro-  
ceed to view the premises taken for said Street and  
described in the plat accompanying this petition &  
having regard to the advantages and disadvantages  
caused to the several propertie along the line of said

Proposed New Street shall make report of the  
damages and assessments for contributions ac-  
cording to law. The Court when due consideration  
had of the premises appointed Mr. Snodgrass, Frank Spotts  
Mr. Davis, John Stay, Alexander Parrott, Martin  
Laughman & D. T. Shaffer as assessors who after  
giving due and legal notice of the time and place  
of meeting shall proceed to view the premises  
and make a full report of their proceedings  
as herein prayed for to the next Court of Quarter  
Sessions and in which report they shall state  
distrinchly that they have been sworn or affirmed  
according to law.





RAIL ROAD STREET.
