public road or highway, to lead from
a private public quad leading from Portage in
Portage Twp. to Franklin Road at a point
near residence of Mr. Sparks in the Township of Portage
and to end in a public road leading from J.C. Knapp
Grist Mill to Franklin Road at a point
near No. 6 School Houses in Summerhill Twp.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint John Watt SURVEYOR, and David Scheibe & H. H. Gray

VIEWERS, to view the ground proposed for said road, and if they view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE.—“It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, in the said state, in favor of assessing and levying an annual tax thereon to aid and answer to the expense of repairing, maintaining, and improving such roads and bridges; and in every case where persons or damages shall fail to prosecute such releases, and it shall appear to them that any building or structure which may be erected upon any land or premises from time to time, and the same may be liable to assessment for the same, they shall be liable to pay the same, levying a rate to the several towns and cities, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners.”





To the Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace, in the within or annexed order named -

With the subscribers appointed by the said Court to view and lay out the road therein mentioned, report, that having been first generally drawn or affixed in the manner and form prescribed by said order that all of us having viewed the ground for the proposed road did concurred and lay out and now return the same for a public road.

Beginning at a point or stake in Township road upon the No. 6 School House in Township of Summershill and running west with said road $N 23^{\circ} W$ 632 ft to a stake at the junction of said road with the public road leading to Bedford County thence along said road $S 52^{\circ} E$ 480 ft to a point east of the residence of Joseph Bushay thence through lands of Catherine Shantz Hays and terminating in lands of Jos. Bushay $N 51^{\circ} 30' E$ 590 ft thence through lands of Jos. Bushay and Henry W. Cornick and terminating in lands W^{rs} Christenwood $N 70^{\circ} E$ 2480 ft, thence through lands of said W^{rs} Christenwood and Jeremiah Barr and B. M^{rs} Polgar
