NOTE—"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every ease where said viewers shall fail to produre such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."
