At a Court of Quarter Sessions held at Ebensburg in and for Said County on Monday July 2nd 1894 before the Hon. A. V. Barker President Judge the petition of Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Summerhill in Said Co. was presented setting forth that on the 5th day of June 1894 an Ordinance of the said Borough was passed reading as follows: An Ordinance authorizing the widening of a portion of the Jackson road within the limits of the Borough of Summerhill County of Cambria and State of Pennsylvania. Be it ordained and enacted by the Burgess and Town Council of the Borough of Summerhill that that portion of the Jackson road lying within the limits of the Borough of Summerhill beginning at a point at or near the corner of Mrs Nancy Reynolds lot and extending to a point at or near the corner of J. D. Wentworths lot should be widened so that the said road or street should be of the width of 30 feet. All ordinances of the Borough of Summerhill in relation to streets and alleys are hereby extended to said Jackson road or street. Ordained and enacted into a Law in Council this 18th day of June A.D. 1894. Your petitioners therefore pray the Court to appoint seven disinterested freeholders of said Borough to view the premises described in said ordinance having regard both to the advantages and disadvantages caused to the several properties along

the line of and adjoining said streets and alleys for the purpose of assessing and allowing to all persons injured thereby such damages as they shall have sustained by reason of the widening of said streets and alleys and also to make assessments or contributions upon all such properties as shall be benefitted by the widening of said streets and alleys in such sums respectively as they may have been benefitted over and above all disadvantages.

The Court upon due consideration had of the premises appointed W. J. McConnell Michael Tully Thos. Seaman Peter Brown Zachariah Dummie John J. McLaughlin Wm. McFarren as viewers who after giving due legal notice of the time and place of meeting shall proceed to view the premises and make a full report of their proceedings as herein prayed for to the next Court of Quarter Sessions of said County and in which report they shall state distinctly they had been sworn or affirmed according to law.

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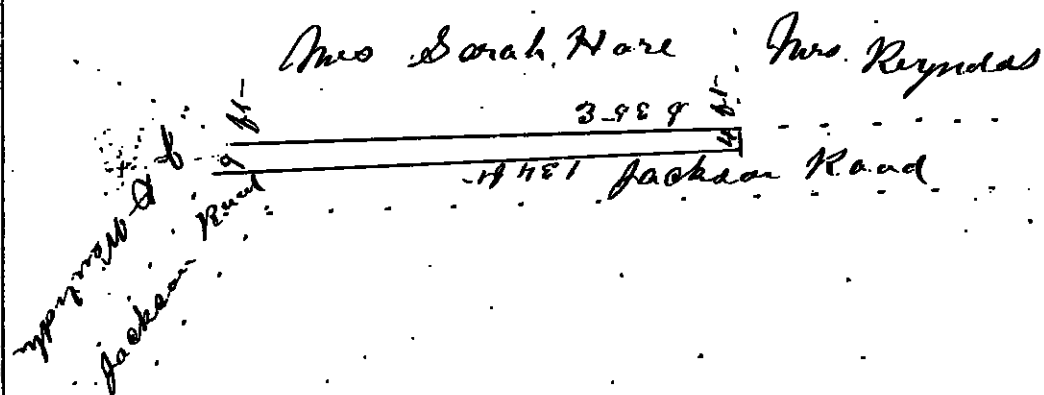
To the Honorable A. W. Barker, President Judge of

We the undersigned persons appointed by the
within order of Court to view and widen the road
therein mentioned, respectfully report: That
having been present at the view of the ground pro-
posed for the widening of such road, & having
been all severally sworn, or affirmed accord-
ing to Law; we met on the 11th day of
August, A. D. 1894, and have viewed & recom-
mend that the said Jackson road be widened
as follows, to wit: Beginning at the corner
of Mrs. Nancy Reynolds lot, thence South one hun-
dred and thirty-four feet to lot of John D. Wentworth,
taking a strip off of Mrs. Sarah Hare's lot
four feet wide at the North and nine feet
wide at the South as will appear more fully
by the draft attached hereto.

The viewers are of the opinion that no damage
will be done to the property of Mrs. Sarah Hare by reason
of widening of said Jackson road as above stated.
