

The above report is excepted to for the following reasons:

FIRST. The view was premature, as a report of viewers covering the same route was set aside by this Court within a year from the date of filing the petition. To this extent the petition was misleading.

SECOND. The viewers did not comply with the law in relation to their duties in assessing damages.

THIRD. The viewers were not sworn as the law required.

FOURTH. The amount awarded the heirs to the Ecklay Estate is grossly inadequate.

FIFTH. The opening of the road would impose an unnecessary burden upon Crescon Township.

SIXTH. The report does not state when the review was had.

SEVENTH. The report is irregular for many other reasons appearing upon its face.

The right to file additional exceptions to said report at any time before the hearing is hereby reserved.


