To the Honorable A. V. Barker, President Judge of the Court of Quarter Séssions of Cambria County:

We, the undersigned, appointed by the annexed order for the purposes therein mentioned do respectfully report, that after giving notice by posting six handbills or notices convenient to the proposed road, as required by law, and by also giving notice thereof to Jacob H. Custer by serving upon him a copy of the notice hereto attached and made part of this report, he being the only person, excepting John H. Seaman, through whose land the said road passes, indicating the time and place of the meeting of the viewers and that it was their purpose to assess any and all damage done to the property over which the same should pass, and all three of the viewers in said order mentioned being present at the time and place appointed in the notices, and having all been first duly sworn or affirmed, viewed the place where the road in said order mentioned is requested, and in pursuance of said order have viewed and laid out and do hereby return for private use, the following road of the width of twenty feet, to wit: Beginning at the residence of John H. Seaman in Croyle Township, thence through his improved land North four degrees and thirty minutes West one hundred feet to a post, thence by same land North forty-seven degrees East three hundred and thirty-nine feet to a post, thence by same land North sixty-one degrees East four hundred and twentyone feet to a post in line of land of Jacob H. Custer, thence through the improved land of Jacob H. Custer North fifty-six degrees and thirty minutes East six hundred and eighteen feet to a post, thence by same land North fifty-nine degrees and thirty minutes East eight hundred and twenty-eight and five-tenth feet to township road leading from the Frankstown road to Knepper's mill, and that the said

NOTE.—"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fall to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report, at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: first, who of them were present at the view; second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams), where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be pro-
