the Court of Quarter sessions of Cambria County Pennsylvania
We the undersigned viewers appointed by the annexed
order respectfully report that after giving notice as
required by law and J. Leard Elder James E. McHugh
and E. R. Dunningan viewers having all been present
at the view of the ground proposed for such road
to be viewed and having all been severally sworn
or affirmed to perform our duties according to law
in pursuance of said order have laid
out and do return for public use the following
road - Beginning at a point in the public road
leading from Mountain Dale to Fringality at or near
a Corner of lands of George Crook thence North twenty two
and one fourth degrees west four hundred and fourteen feet
thence North twenty three degrees west eight hundred and fifty
five feet thence North eighty eight and one fourth degrees west
three hundred and eighty eight feet thence North eighty seven
and one half degrees west five hundred feet thence North
eighty three and one half degrees west two hundred and thirty
five feet thence South seventy one degrees west four hundred
and eighty three feet thence North fifty five degrees west
two hundred and seventy seven feet thence North forty
six degrees west four hundred and sixty eight feet
thence North twenty eight degrees west four hundred
and nine feet to a point in the public road
leading from Glasgow to Van Courer at or near the land
of J. C. Marks no damages allowed said road as

COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, }
COUNTY OF CAMBRIA, } SS:

At a Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria held at Ebensburg in the said County, on the twentieth day of December A. D. 1899, before the Honorable Judge of the said Court: Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Reade, in the said County, setting forth that they labor under inconvenience for want of a public road or highway, to lead from a point in the public road leading from Mountaindale to Frugality at or near a corner of lands of George Cress and extending to a point in the public road leading from Glasgow to Van Orman's near the lands of J. C. Marks. They further state that there is at the present time a private road extending over the same route referred to above from the point of beginning to the point of ending as described above and that the same does not meet with the requirements of the traveling public.

and therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to—view and lay out the same according to law. The Court upon due consideration had of the premises, do order and appoint

J. Laird Elder SURVEYOR, and James E. McLaughlin and E. R. Dunnegan VIEWERS, to—view the ground proposed for said road, and if they—view the same, and shall agree that there is occasion for such road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desires of the petitioners, and that they make a report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public or private road, together with a plot or draft thereof, and the courses and distances, and references to the improvements through which it may pass.

NOTE.—"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report, at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: first, who of them were present at the view; second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams,) where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
