IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMERIA COUNTY.

To the Hon. A. V. Barker, Judge of said Court:-

The petition of the Valley Pike Company respectfully represents that the said Company has heretofore been duly incorporated under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that its roadway has been completed, sometime previous to the date of this petition, its entire length, beginning at its intersection with the Johnstown and Bens Creek Turnpike, in the Eighth Ward of the City of Johnstown, and ending at the Johnstown and Somerset Plank Road, in Upper Yoder Township.

Your petitioner, therefore, respectfully prays the Court to appoint three skillful, judicious and disinterested persons, under Sec. 30 of the Act of April 29, 1374, entitled, "An Act to Provide for the Incorporation and Regulation of Certain Corporations," approved 29 April, 1374, to view and examine the same and report on oath or affirmation whether said road is so far executed in a competent and workmanlike manner, according to the true intent and meaning of the Act of Assembly. And if their report be in the affirmative, it is further prayed that the Court will order and permit, under seal of said Court, the said Corporation to erect and fix such and so many gates upon and across said road as will be necessary and sufficient to collect from all persons, otherwise than those on foot, the tolls authorized by the Act of Assembly.

And as in duty bound your petitioner will forever pray.

ORDER TO VIEW.

And so, August 1st., A.D.1893, the petition of the Valley Pike  
Company, setting forth the completion of its Turnpike road, and asking  
for the appointment of viewers to examine and report, being before the  
Court, it is ordered and decreed that A. D. Hasbrouck, Daniel Cauffiel,  
and John Lambert, being three skillful, judicious, and disinterested  
persons, he and they are hereby appointed to view and examine the  
Valley Pike Company's turnpike road from Franklin Street, in the Eighth  
Ward of the City of Johnstown, to its intersection with the Johnstown  
and Somerset plank road, in Upper Yoder Township, Cambria County, going  
the entire length of said turnpike; and being duly sworn or affirmed to  
well and truly discharge the duties of said viewers, they shall report  
to the Court on the first day of the next Term, whether said turnpike  
road is executed in a competent and workmanlike manner, according to  
the true intent and meaning of the Act of Assembly, approved the 29th  
day of April, A.D.1874, entitled, "An Act to provide for the Incorpora-  
tion and regulation of certain Corporations."
