IN THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS OF CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENN'A.

To the Honorable A. V. Barker, President Judge of said Court:

The undersigned, a majority of the bridge viewers named in the within or annexed order, respectfully represent,

I.-- That they met at the time and place specified in the notice, to wit, on the 28th day of April, A.D., 1899, at the place where the proposed bridge is to be built, as mentioned in the petition and order of court, a copy of which notice is hereto attached and made a part of this report; six or more of which notices were posted in the most public places in the vicinity of the ground to be viewed, in both the adjacent townships and also at the place of the proposed bridge, at least ten days prior to the holding of said view, giving due public notice;

II.-- That they were first severally sworn or affirmed according to law before proceeding to discharge their duties, and having been so sworn proceeded to view the site and locality of the bridge proposed to be built, making a personal inspection of the ground at and near the point designated in the petition and order, on the date named in the said view, and also ascertaining the owner of the ground at and near the site of the proposed bridge,

III.-- That they were of the opinion and agreed that a bridge at the point mentioned is necessary and will be too expensive for the said townships of Adams and Croyle to build, and they therefore lay out and return for public use a bridge as follows:

Over the South Fork Creek on the line between the townships of Adams and Croyle where said creek is crossed by the public road leading from Lovett to the Frankstown road; that the owner of the ground on which said bridge would be located is the South Fork Hunting & Fishing Club, and that no change of location from the present site of the public road at the place of

the proposed bridge is neccessary; that a map of the location of said proposed bridge as viewed by the undersigned is hereby annexed and made a part of this report, showing all necessary details as to location, length of span, etc.; that they suggest that the bridge be made of iron or steel with a span of seventy-five feet in the clear, and have substantial stone abutments.

IV.-- They further report that they find that no loss or damage would result to the owners of the land at the place of the location of said bridge, and that no persons claimed any damages,

V.-- That Emanuel Gramling, the other person named in the annexed order as a viewer, was unable to be present at said view.

across the South Fork of the Little Conemaugh river

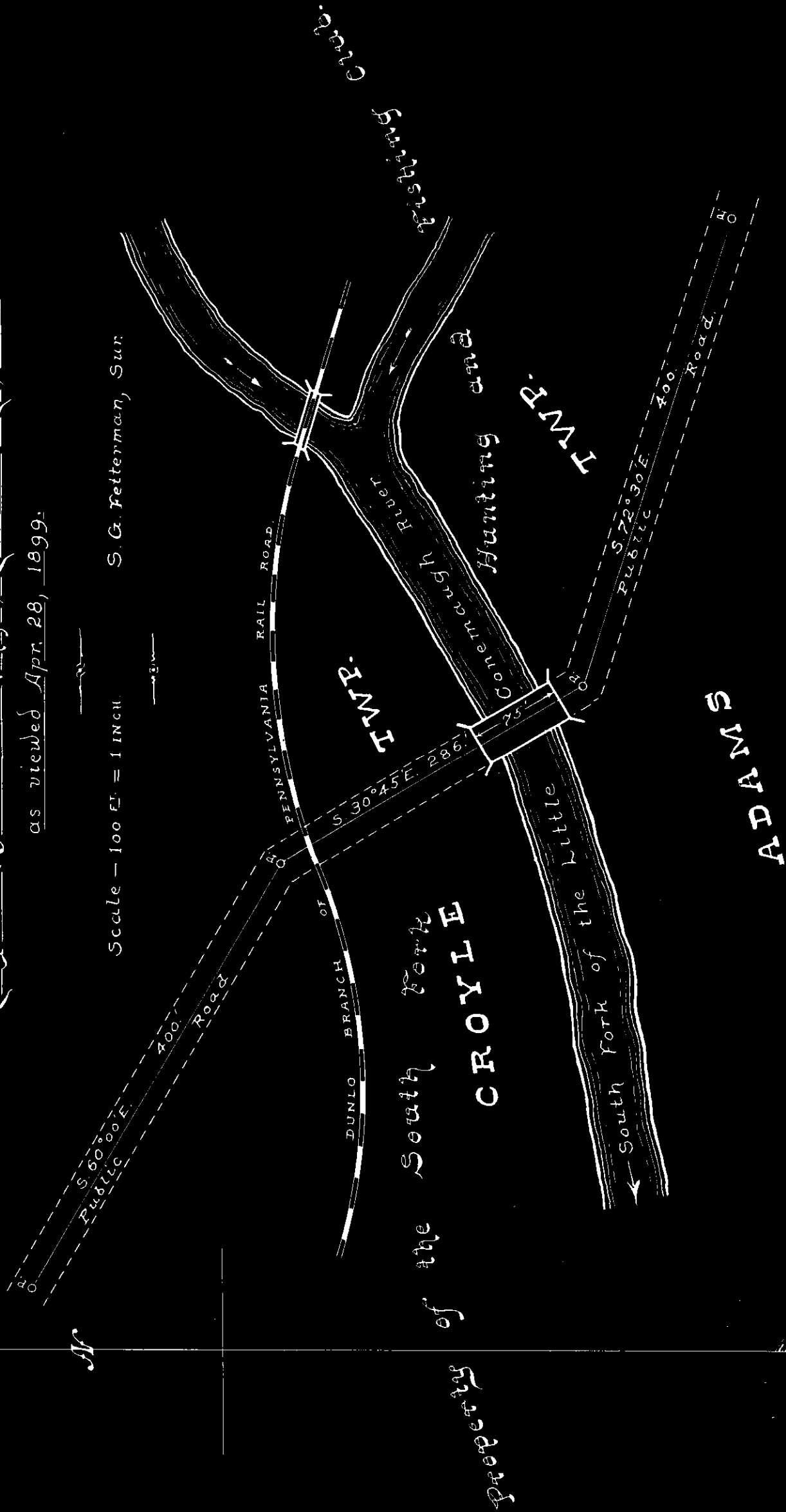
