

To the Honorable A. V. Barker President
Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Cambria County.

The petition of the undersigned citizens
of Carroll townships and adjoining dis-
tricts Respectfully Represents: That a
Public Road has long since been laid
out leading from Carrolltown Borough
via of "Bakers Cross Roads" to the Village
of St. Boniface, in Elder township, parts
of which your petitioners represent
have become inconvenient and burden-
some and we therefore pray the Court
to appoint viewers to view, vacate
and supply the same to wit: that
portion of said road from a point
just North of the crossing of the Cam-
bria County (Beech Creek) R. R. north-
ward to a point just South of the
Cross Roads is in the Spring and fall
seasons so muddy as to be almost im-
passable, and is hilly and a drawback
to hauling or travel; while in the Winter
it is utterly impassable on ac-
count of snow-drifts and is a
burden to the Township on account of
damages it has paid and expense of
opening &c, &c. Last year the Township

was compelled to pay \$46.⁰⁰ damages on account of public travel through fields of Mrs. E. Wentz, and in the past ten years this amount will run up to \$250.⁰⁰ for damages &c. The amount expended this winter already reaching \$25.⁰⁰ It is desired to supply this piece of bad and expensive road by changing the same from a point just North of the crossing of said railroad near northern line of Carrolltown Borough, to a direction Northwest to a point on line of lands of Mrs. E. Wentz and John Lantz, sr; thence along said line in a northerly direction to land of Jacob Germ's heirs and continuing northward across said land to a point on the road to be vacated and supplied at or near the place where the cleared land and woodland join on said Germ place. This road would be inexpensive to make, has good natural drainage, would avoid the steep hills of the present road, and would not drift in winter but could be travelled all the year round.

We therefore ask that viewers be

appointed to view, vacate and properly
the said road and we will ever pay.
