TO THE HONORABLE A.V.BARKER PRESIDENT JUDGE OF THE COURT OF QUARTER SESSIONS IN AND FOR THE COUNTY OF CAMBRIA.

The petition of the undersigned inhabitants of the Townships of Blacklick and Jacksonin the said County of Cambria, Respectively represents:

That it is necessary that a bridge should be erected over the South Branch of the Blacklick Creek where said Creek divides said Townships, and crosses the Township road which leads from the Clay Pike to the Stone Pike, at a point at or near the Pennsylvania Rail-road depot at or near the Town of Twin Rocksin said Township of Blacklick.

That the erecting of said bridge will require more expense than is reasonable the said Townships of Blacklick and Jackson should bear.

Your petitions therefore pray the Court to appoint three persons qualified according to law ,to view the place proposed for said bridge, and inquire whether such bridge is necessary and would be too expensive for said Townships of Blacklick and Jackson to bear, and make report of their proceedings at the next term of this Court. And they will pray &c.

The Strandswars of Sept Germ 1901 do recommend that the County Construct the Bridge as reported within-L Robeits Gareman

"The viewers, as a foresaid, shall make report, at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: first, who viewers the road desired be necessary for a public or private road; they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the provements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding from the crossing of ravines and streams.) where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may preserved within that limit."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to ay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the hest ground for a road, and is such manner as shall do the least injury to price process."

That it having appeared to the Court, to the Grand Jury, and the Commissioners

having been entered of record, your petitioners procured an estimate to be made as
nearly as might be, of the expense of the same, and did proceed to have such bridge
erected by entering into a contract with C. D. Sollschall,
of Dlacklick Jownship for the building of the substructure for
the sum of \$ 975 ; and with the Owego Bridge Co.
of the State of New York, for the building of the superstructure
for the sum of \$ 1,460 ; and that the said bridge is now completed
agreeably to the said contracts.

Your petitioners, therefore, pray the Court to appoint, six fit persons to inspect said bridge and the workmanship thereof, agreeably to the Act of Assembly, and to make report to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held in and for the said County.
