

To the Honorable A. V. Barker, President
Judge of the Court of Quarter Sessions of
Camden County.

The petition of the undersigned
inhabitants of the Township of Summerhill,
in the county aforesaid respectfully represents:

That at the March Sessions 1894 of this
Court a petition was presented for an order to
vacate and supply part of a public road in
said Township leading from Chenoweth Road to wit:
from Settlementers School House to a point near
bridge on land of Philip Kelly, &c. That the report
of the viewers was filed at the June Sessions 1894.
That at Sept. Sessions 1894 a petition for a re-
view was filed and reviewers appointed and
their report was filed at the March Sessions
1895. That on Oct 26, 1896 the report of
the viewers was confirmed absolutely.

See Road Docket Vol. 4 page 341, at
No. 2 March Sessions 1894. That
since said confirmation the said road
has been opened in part, to wit: as far as
the line of William Enigh. The rest remains
unopened largely on account of the swampy
location and the very steep grade of its location
making it costly to build, expensive to keep
in repair. They represent that a much
better location, grade, &c may be had for
said remaining unopened part of said
road.

The petitioners therefore pray ~~you to vacate~~
~~and~~ of the premises and to vacate and
supply said unopened part of said

mentioned road, beginning at a point about 50 yards east of the residence of William Smith on said road and ending at or near a bridge on lands of Philip Skelly and for that purpose to appoint three persons, qualified according to law, to view said road make report of their proceedings at the next term of this court and they will ever pray
