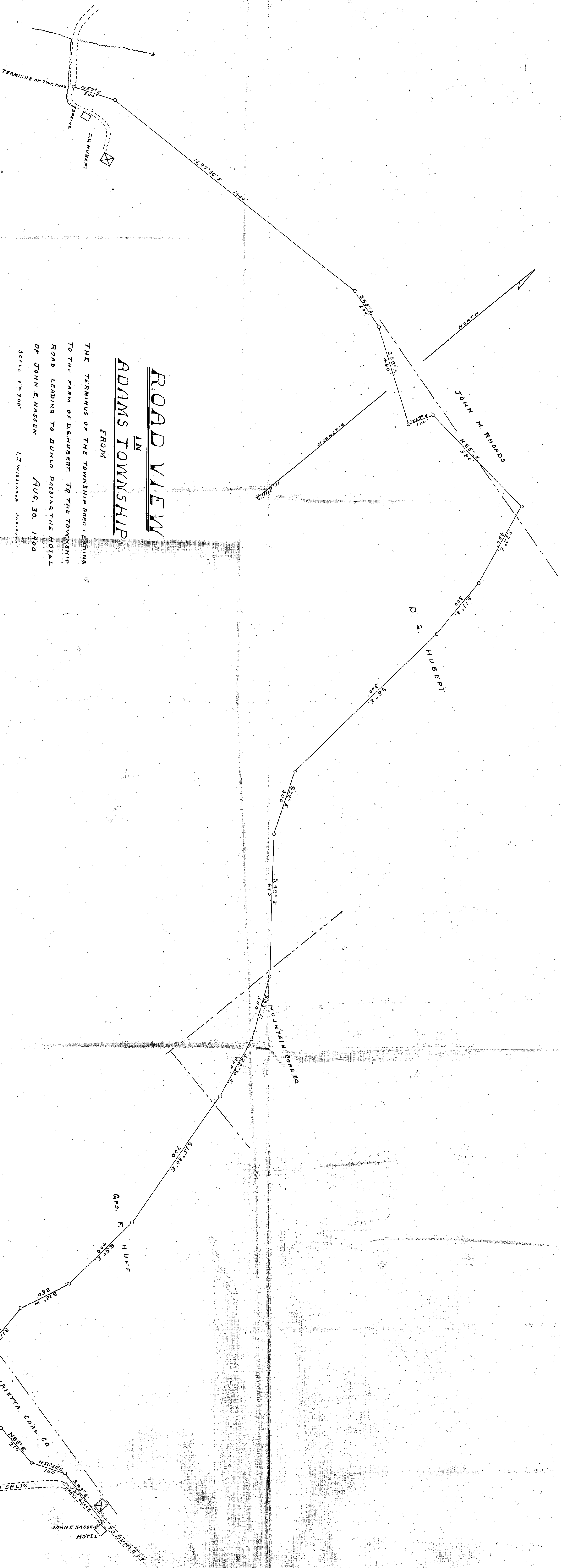

We, the subscribers, appointed by the annexed order to review the road herein mentioned, do report that, in pursuance of said order, due and legal notice of the time and place of meeting was given by posting the required number of notices in public places in the vicinity of the proposed road, and serving copies of said notice on the Supervisors of the Township of Adams, and upon the County Commissioners; and that, having been all present and first severally sworn according to law, we have reviewed the following road, to-wit:

Beginning in Township road, at or near the spring on the farm of D. G. Hubert, near the terminus of the Township road leading to said farm in Adams Township, north, 57° E., 200 feet to a post; thence through improved land of D. G. Hubert north, $77^{\circ} 30'$ E., 1400 feet to post; thence south, 85° E., 200 feet through same to post; thence south, 68° E., 460 feet through same to post; thence north, 19° E., 120 feet through same to post; thence north, 85° E., 580 feet through same land and improved land of John M. Rhoads to post; thence south, 22° E., 400 feet through improved land of John M. Rhoads and D. G. Hubert 400 feet to post; thence south, 11° E., through improved land of said Hubert 300 feet to post; thence south, 5° E., through same 900 feet to post; thence south,

33° E., through same 300 feet to post; thence south, 49° E., through same 550 feet to post in land of Mountain Coal Company; thence south, 35° E., through land of Mountain Coal Company 300 feet to post; thence south, 22 1/2 ° E., through same 300 feet to post; thence south, 15 1/2 ° E., through land of same and land of George F. NOTE.—"It shall be the duty of all persons appointed in the several counties of this Commonwealth to view and review any public or private road or bridge, if they shall decide in favor of locating said road or bridge, to endeavor to procure from the person or persons over whose land such location may be made releases from all claims for damages that might arise from the opening of such road or the building of such bridge; and in every case where said viewers shall fail to procure such releases, and it shall appear to them that any damages will be sustained, it shall be their duty to assess the damages and make report thereof signed by a majority of their number, and return the same, together with all releases obtained, to the Court of Quarter Sessions, and the damages so assessed shall be conclusive, or may be subject to appeal, review or modification, as may be provided by existing laws in the different counties of this Commonwealth."

"The persons appointed as aforesaid shall view such ground, and if they shall agree that there is occasion for a road, they shall proceed to lay out the same, having respect to the shortest distance, and the best ground for a road, and in such manner as shall do the least injury to private property, and also be, as far as practicable, agreeable to the desire of the petitioners."

"The viewers, as aforesaid, shall make report, at the next term of said Court, and in the said report shall state particularly: first, who of them were present at the view; second, whether they were severally sworn or affirmed; third, whether the road desired be necessary for a public or private road: they shall also annex and return to the Court a plot or draft thereof, stating the courses and distances, and noting briefly the improvements through which it may pass; and, whenever practicable, the viewers shall lay out the said roads at an elevation not exceeding five degrees (except at the crossing of ravines and streams,) where, by moderate filling and bridging, the declination of the road may be preserved within that limit."
