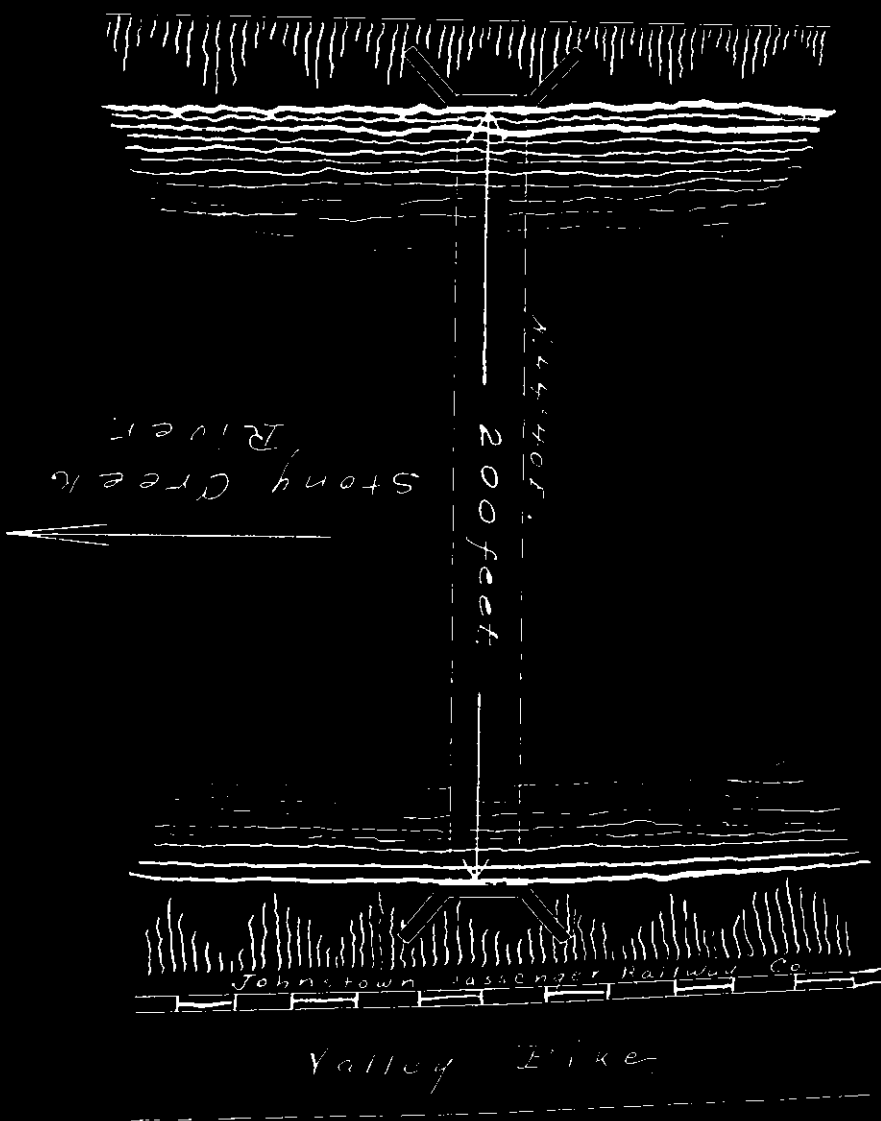

At the Court of Quarter Sessions of the Peace of the County of Cambria, held at Ebensburg, in and for said County, on Monday, the third day of March, A.D. 1902, before Honorable F. J. Connor, Judge of said Court

Upon the petition of divers inhabitants of the Township of Stony Creek, in the said County setting forth that they labor under great inconveniences for want of a public road or highway to lead from a point on the Johnstown and Scalp Level Turnpike near the old Wessinger homestead to a point on a township road leading from Johnstown and Scalp Level Turnpike to Moxham, 17th Ward, City of Johnstown,

And therefore praying the Court to appoint proper persons to view and lay out the same, according to law; the court, on due consideration, does order and appoint

who after being respectively sworn to perform the duties of their appointment impartially and to the best of their judgment, are to view the ground proposed for the said road; and if they view the same, and agree that there is occasion for such a road, they shall proceed to lay

out the same, as agreeable to the desire of the petitioners as may be, having respect to the best ground for a road, and the shortest distance, and in such a manner as to do the least injury to private property; and shall make report of their proceedings to the next Court of Quarter Sessions to be held for the said County, stating particularly whether they judge the same necessary for a public road; and furnish with said report, a plot or draft of said road, and the courses and distances, together with references to the improvements through which it may pass
